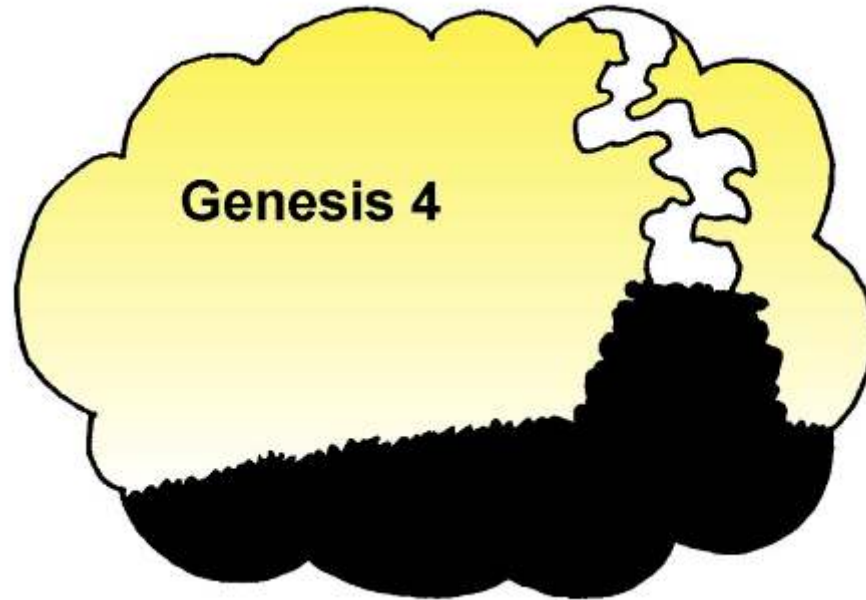
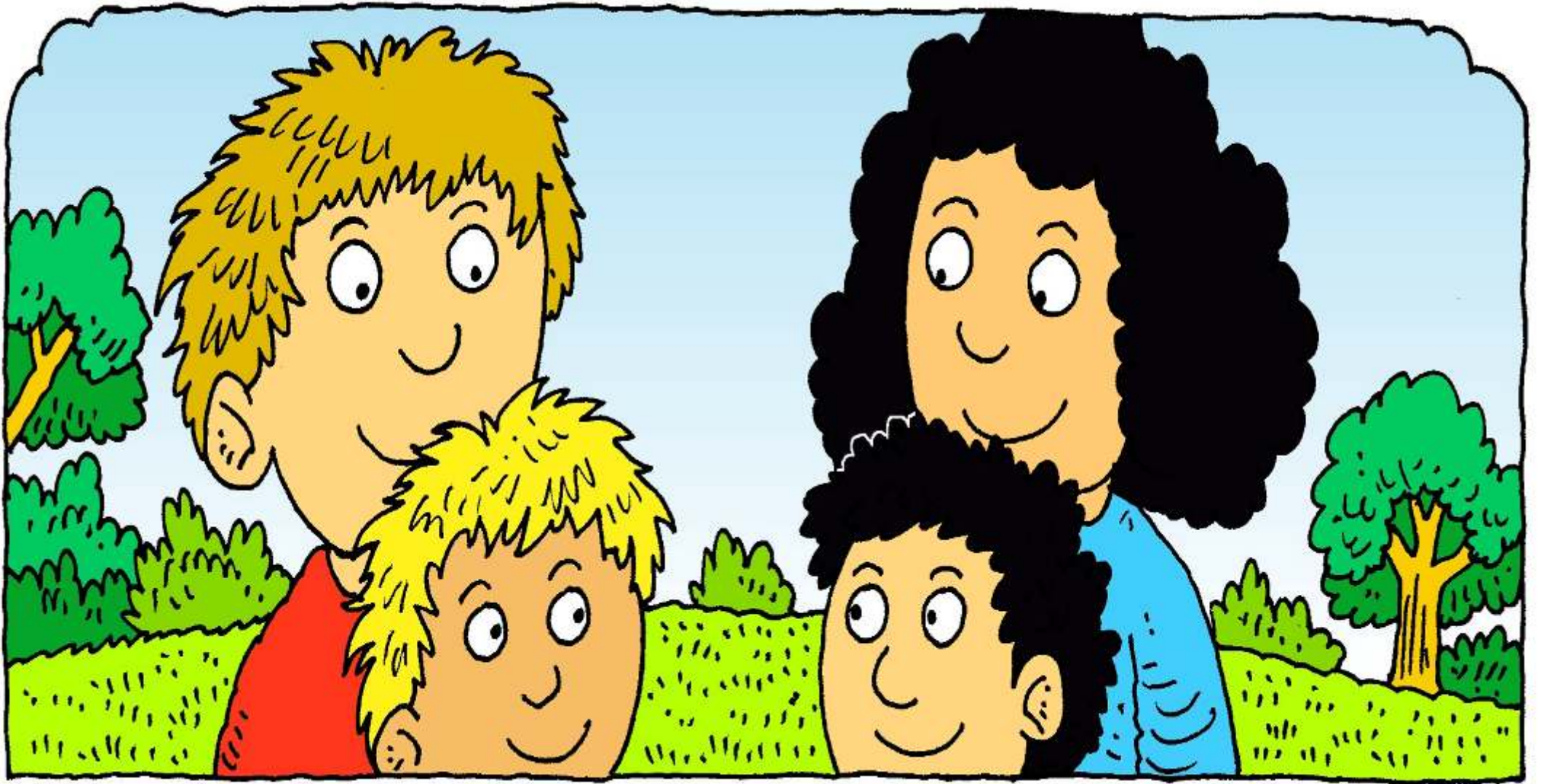


# Cain And Abel

first Cain and then Abel.

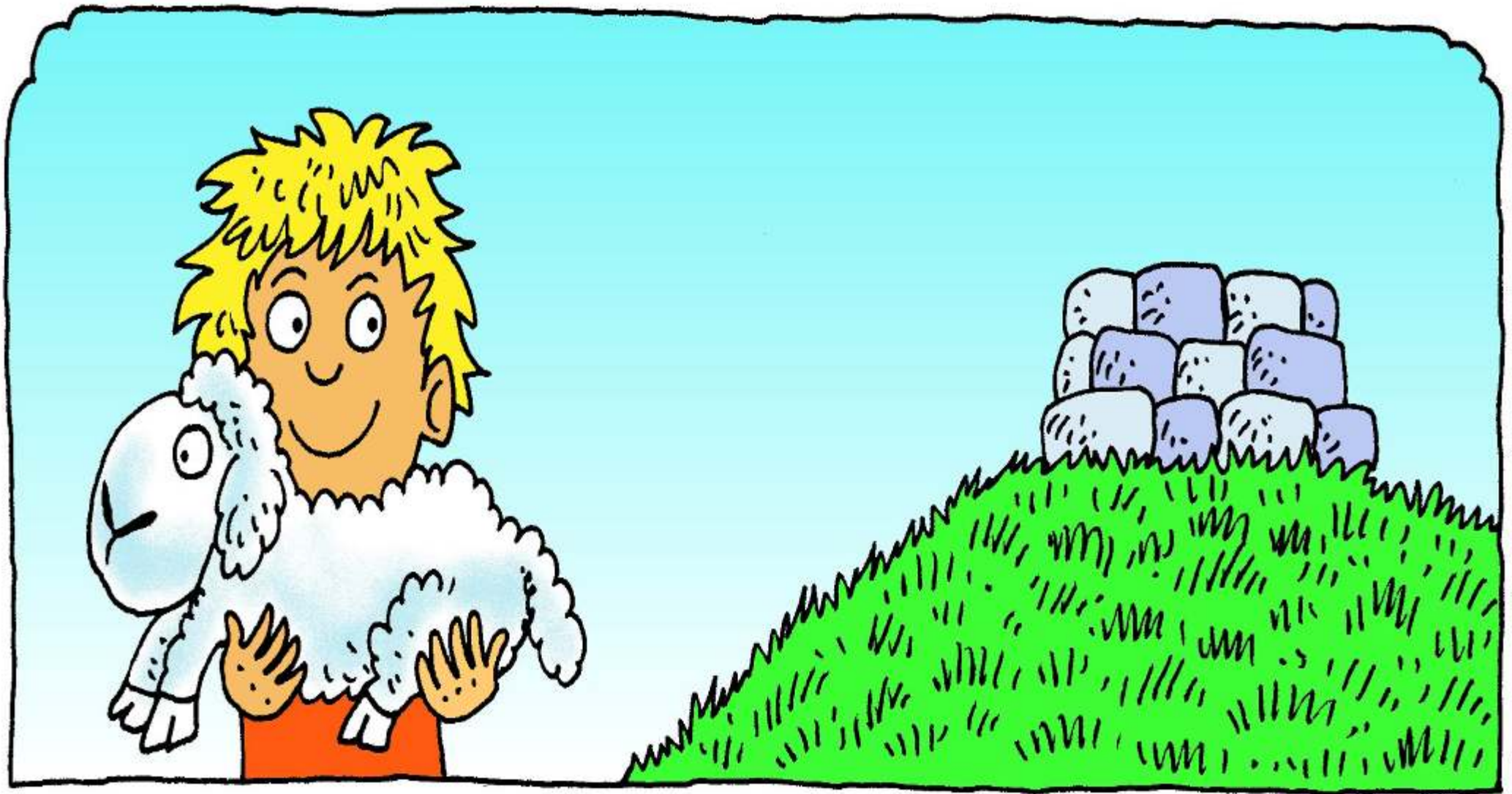


Cain loved to grow vegetables,

and weeding the garden.



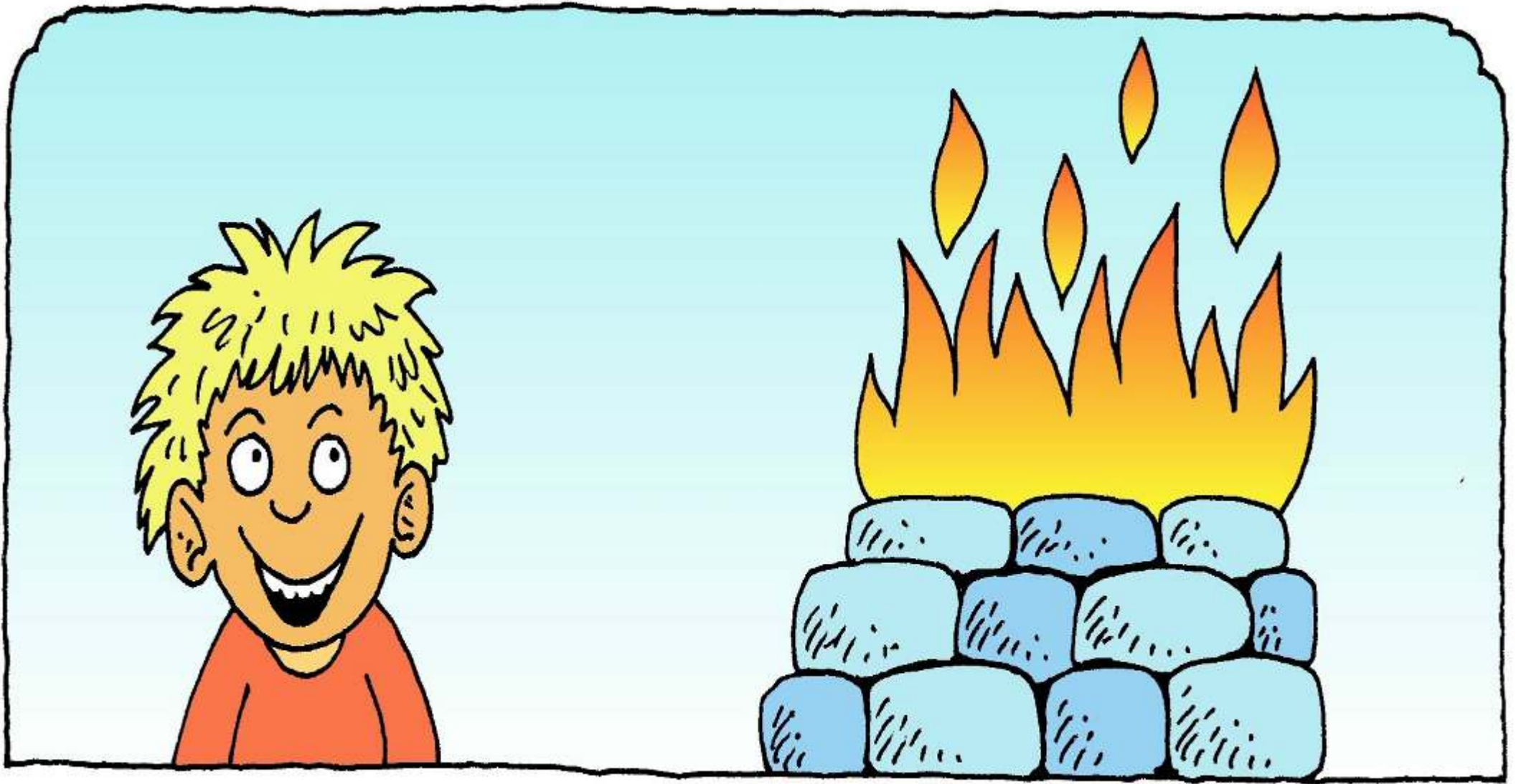
He brought the first of all

“I will show God what I can do,” he thought.

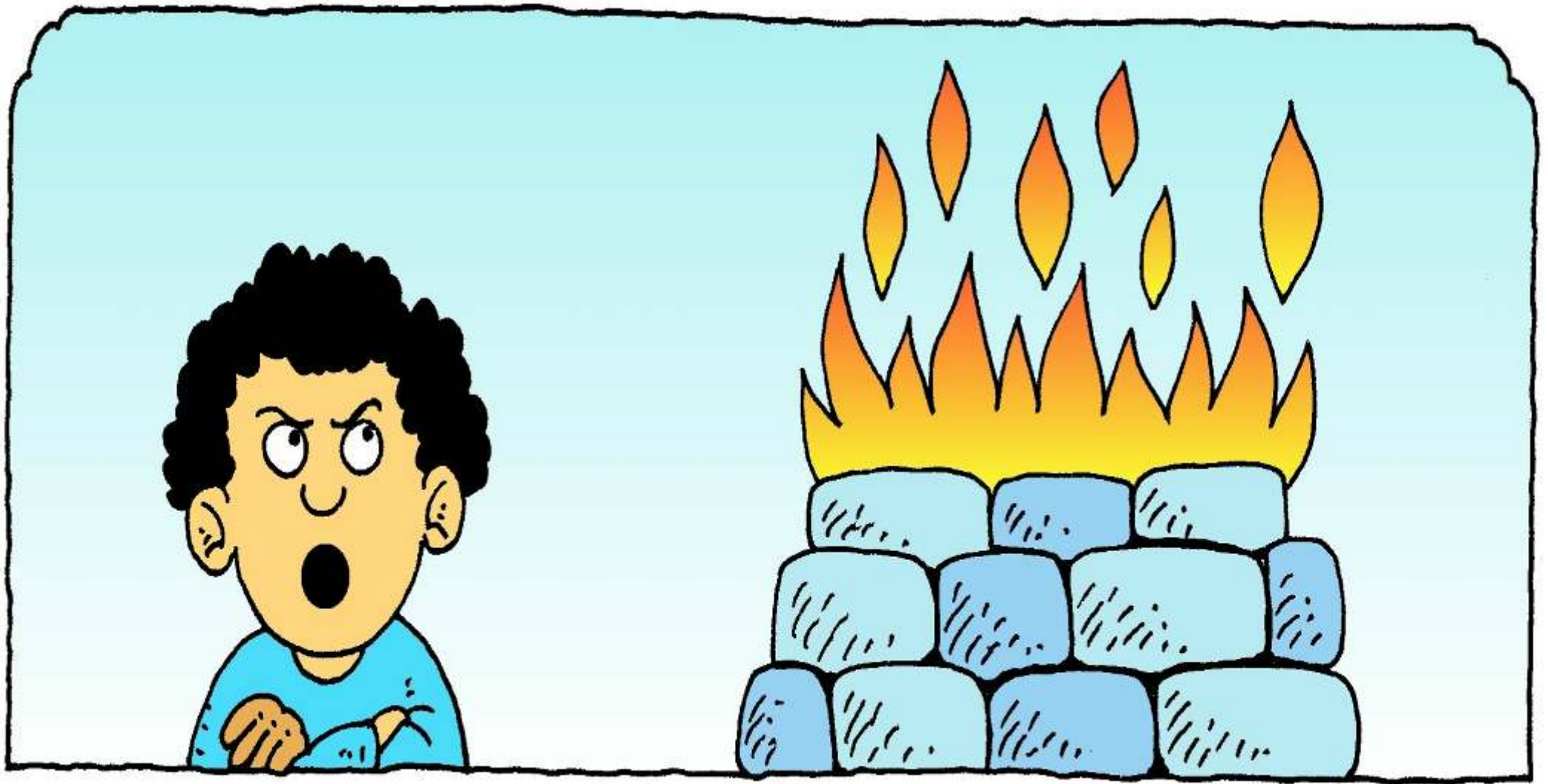


Abel looked after the sheep.

as a gift to God.

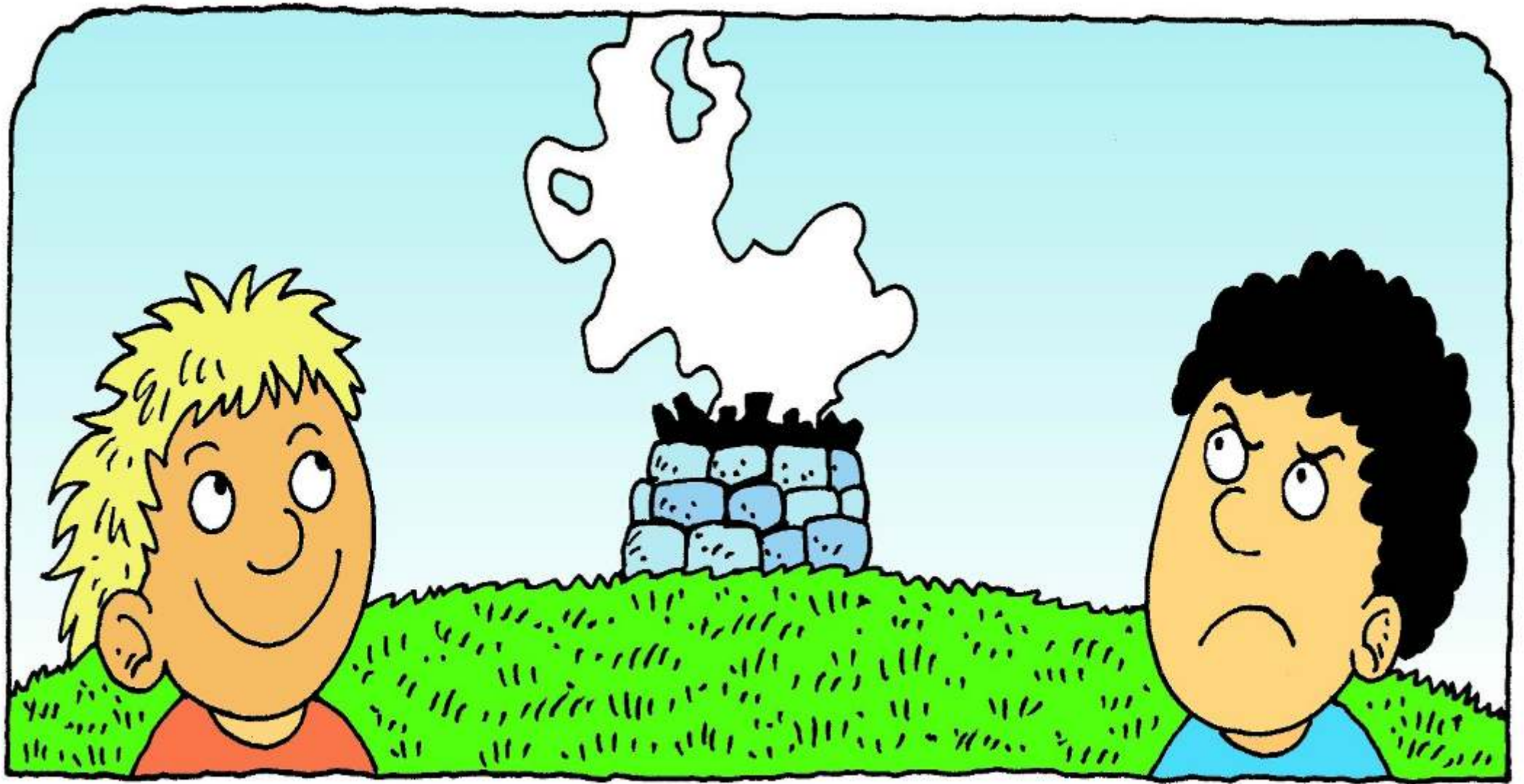
“Thank you God for everything you give to me,” he prayed.
