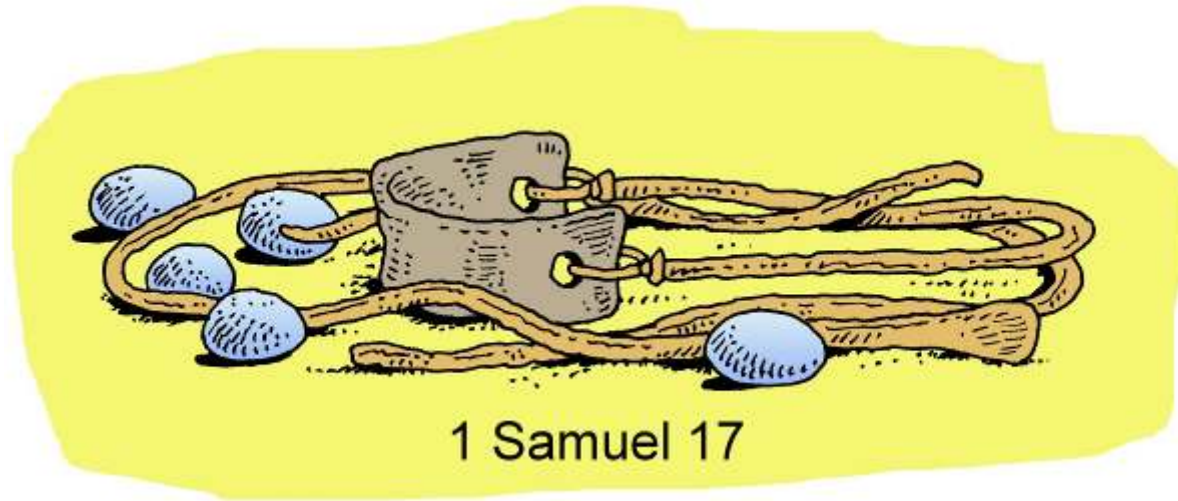


David Is Brave

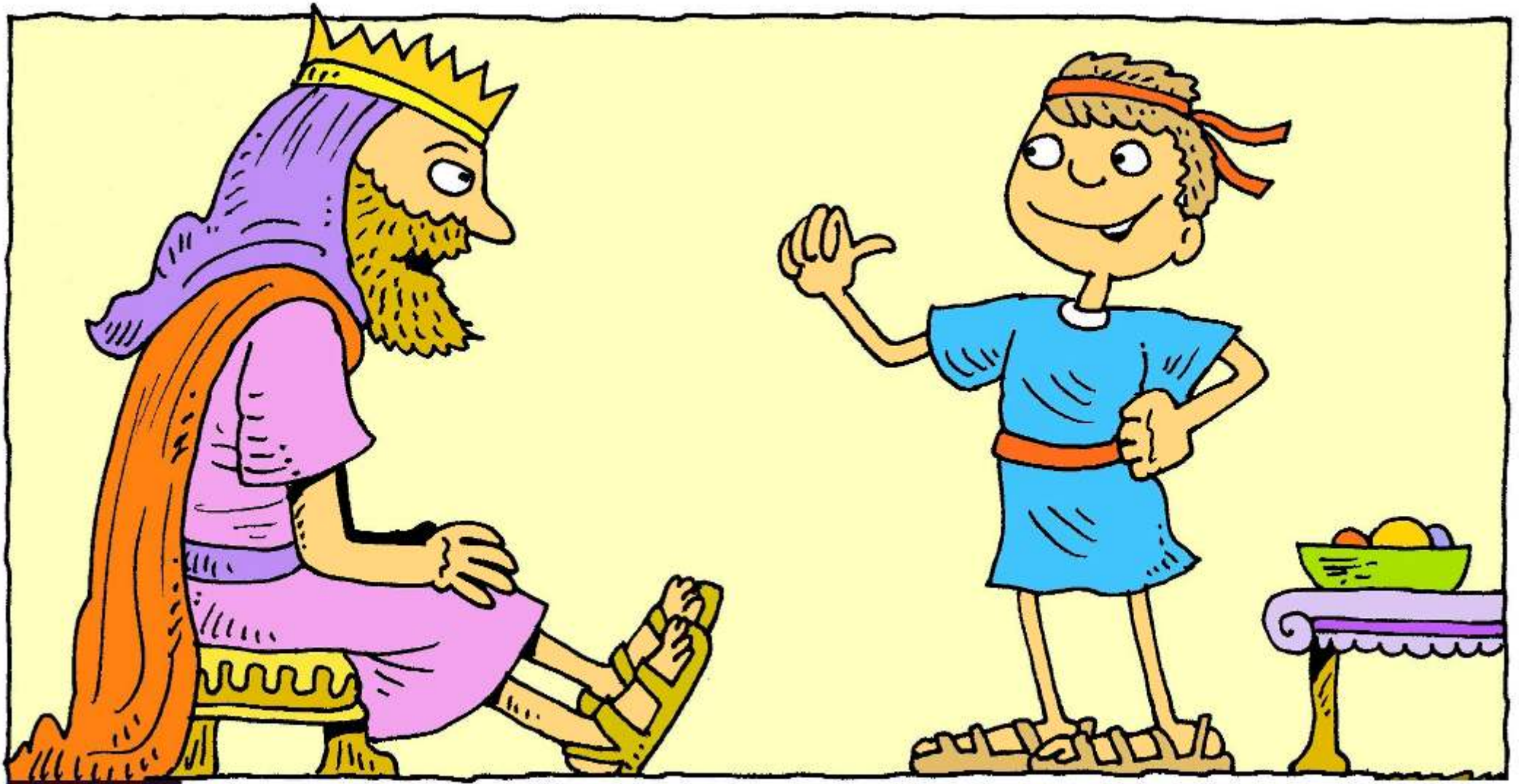
1 Samuel 17



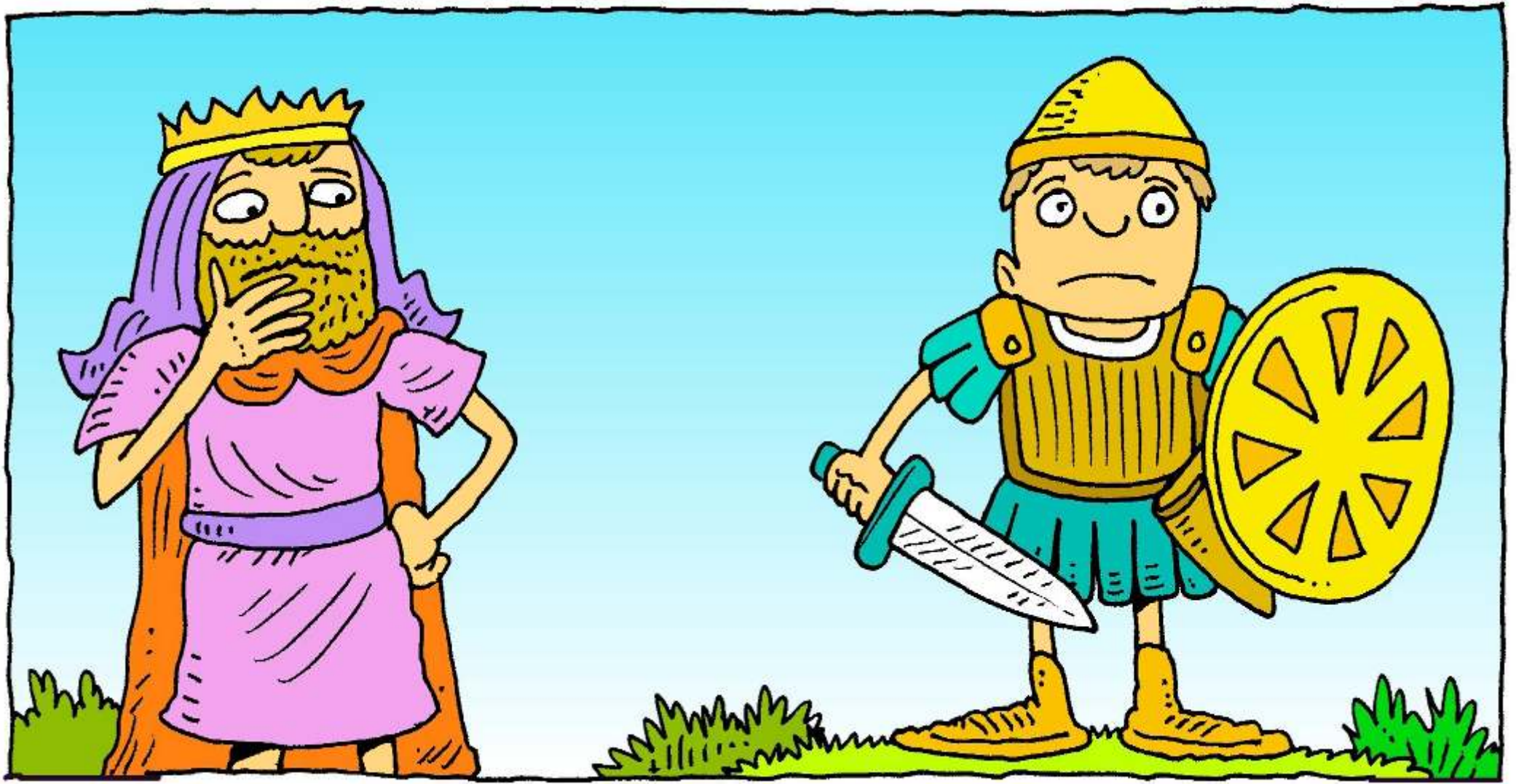
One day David had to leave his sheep.

"God is bigger than him!"



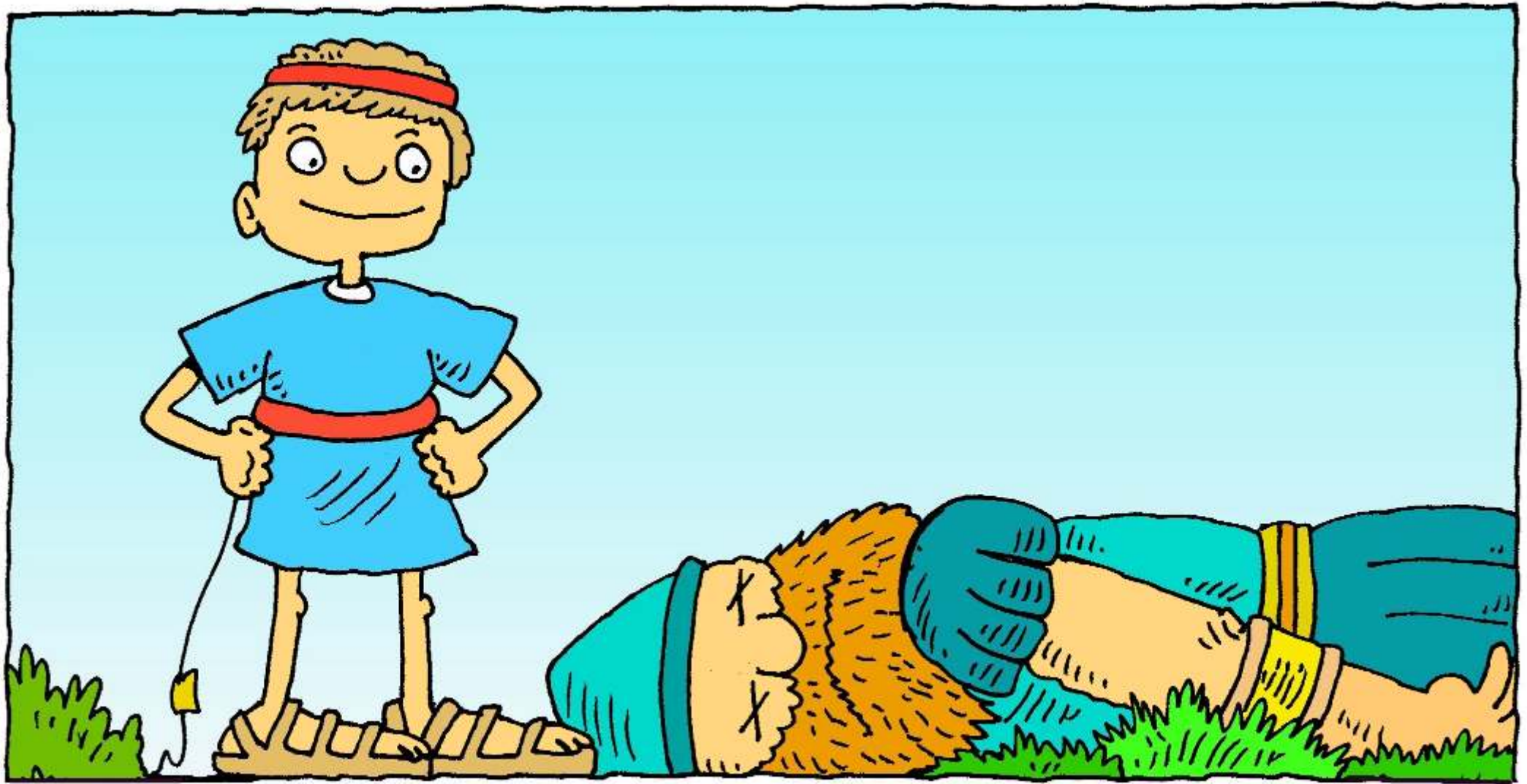
David went to see the king. "I will fight Goliath," he said. "God helped me to fight a hungry lion and a hungry bear. God will help me to win."
