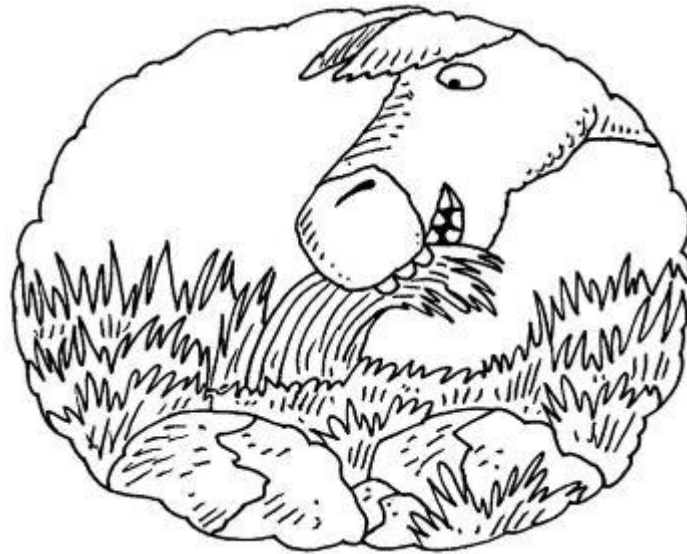
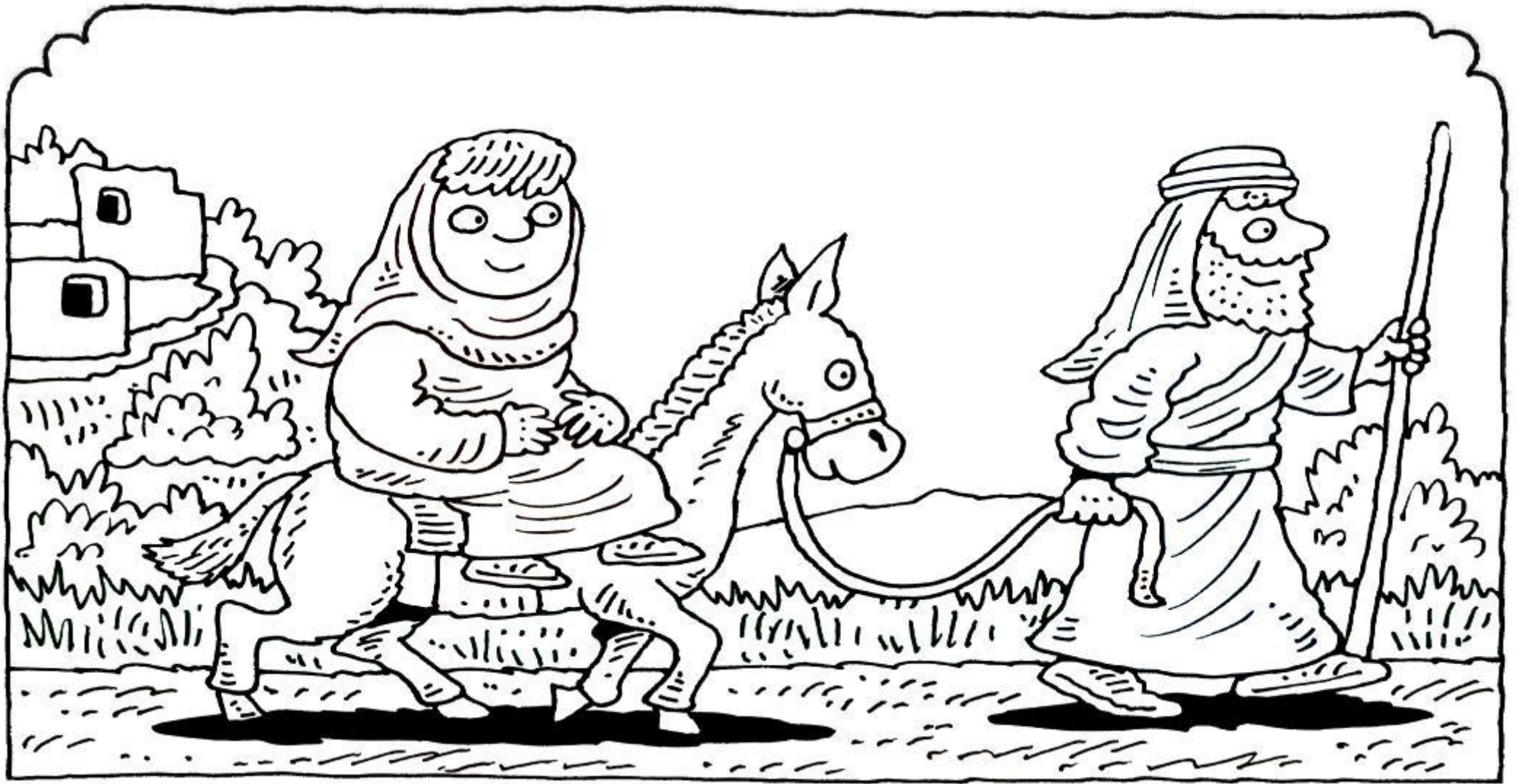


Donkey's Special Christmas Night

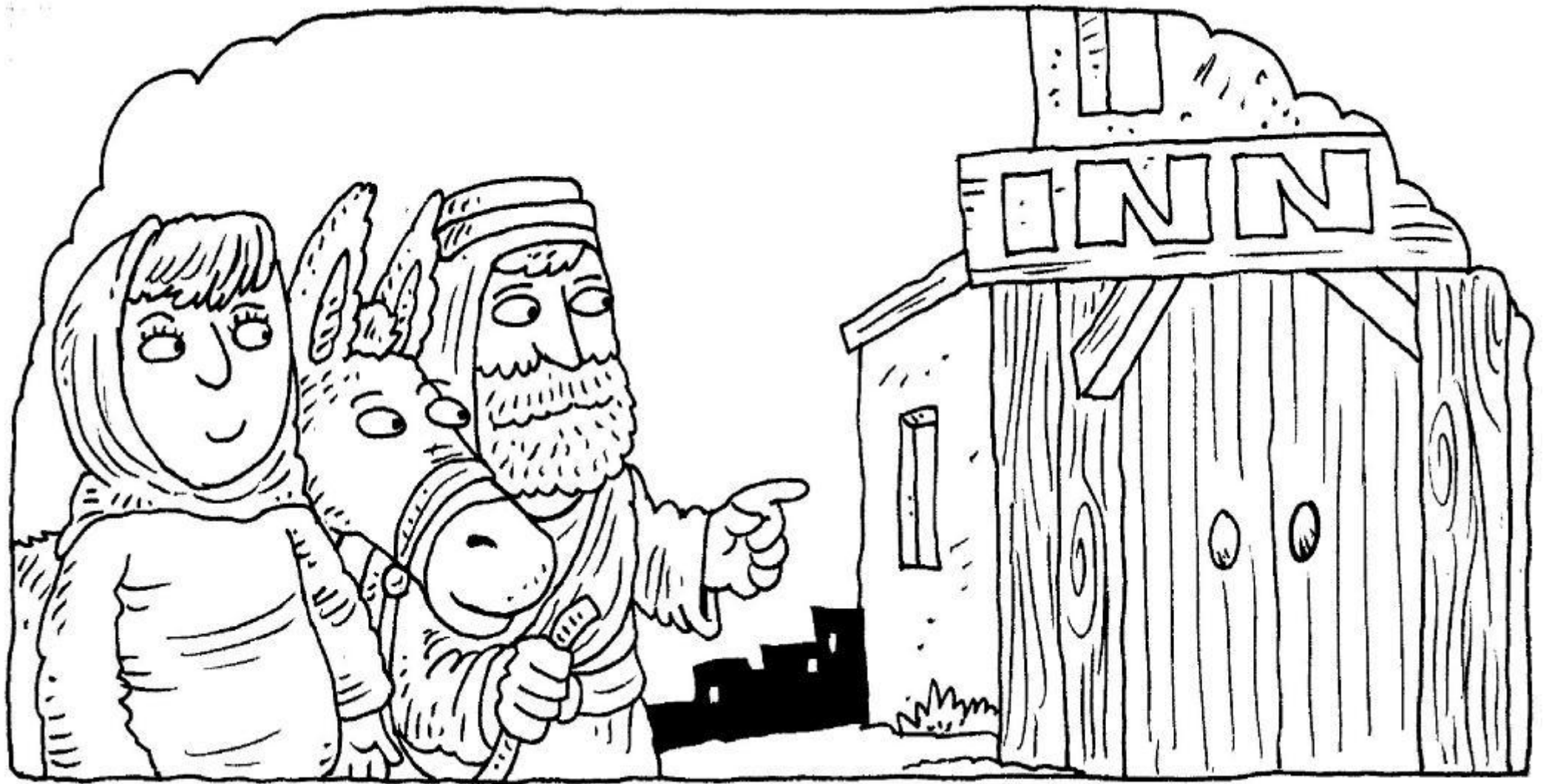
Joseph lived in Nazareth.

It was the new rule. Mary went too.



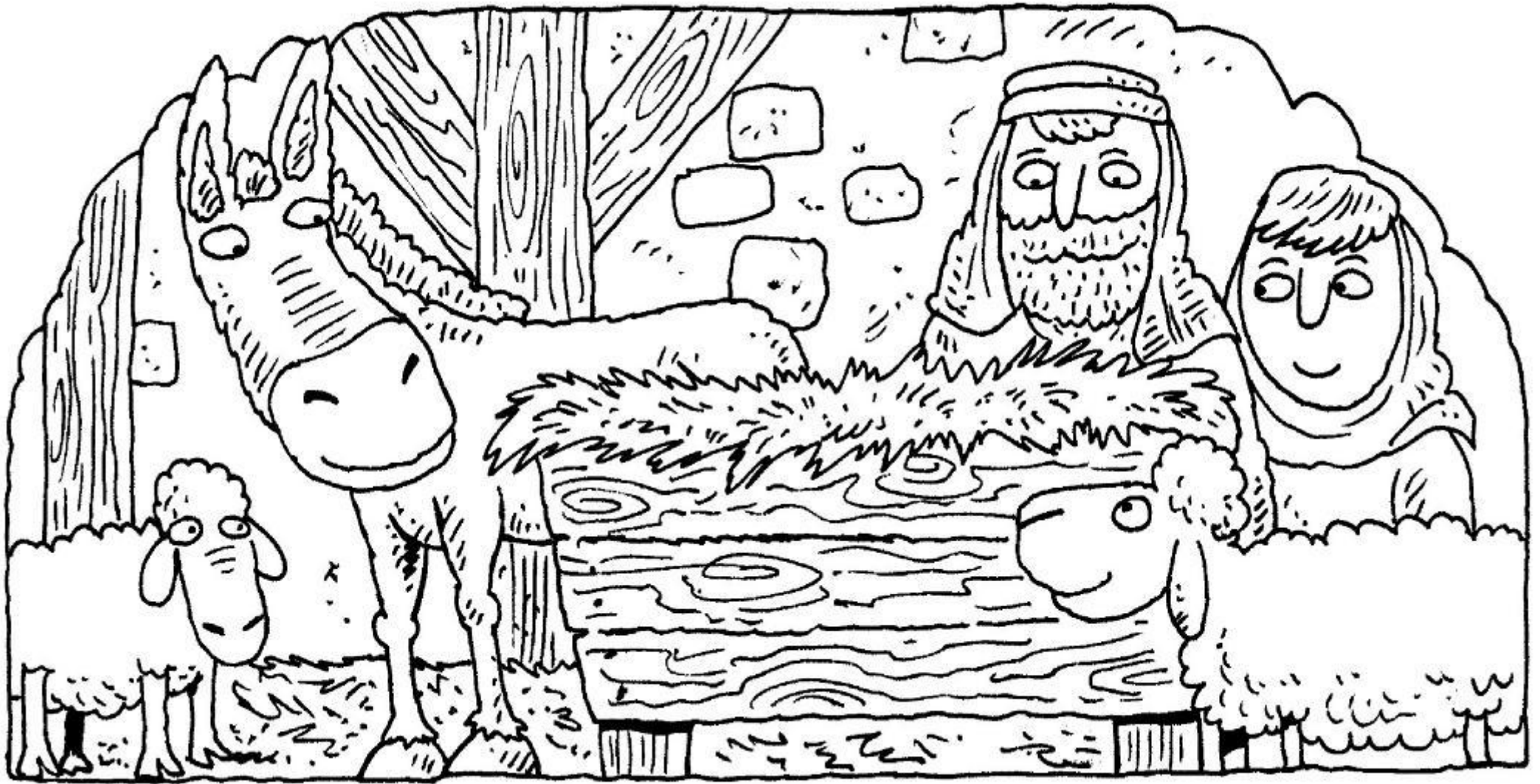
Donkey heard Joseph and Mary say that they had seen an angel who told them that Mary would have a baby boy. He was the promised Son of God!



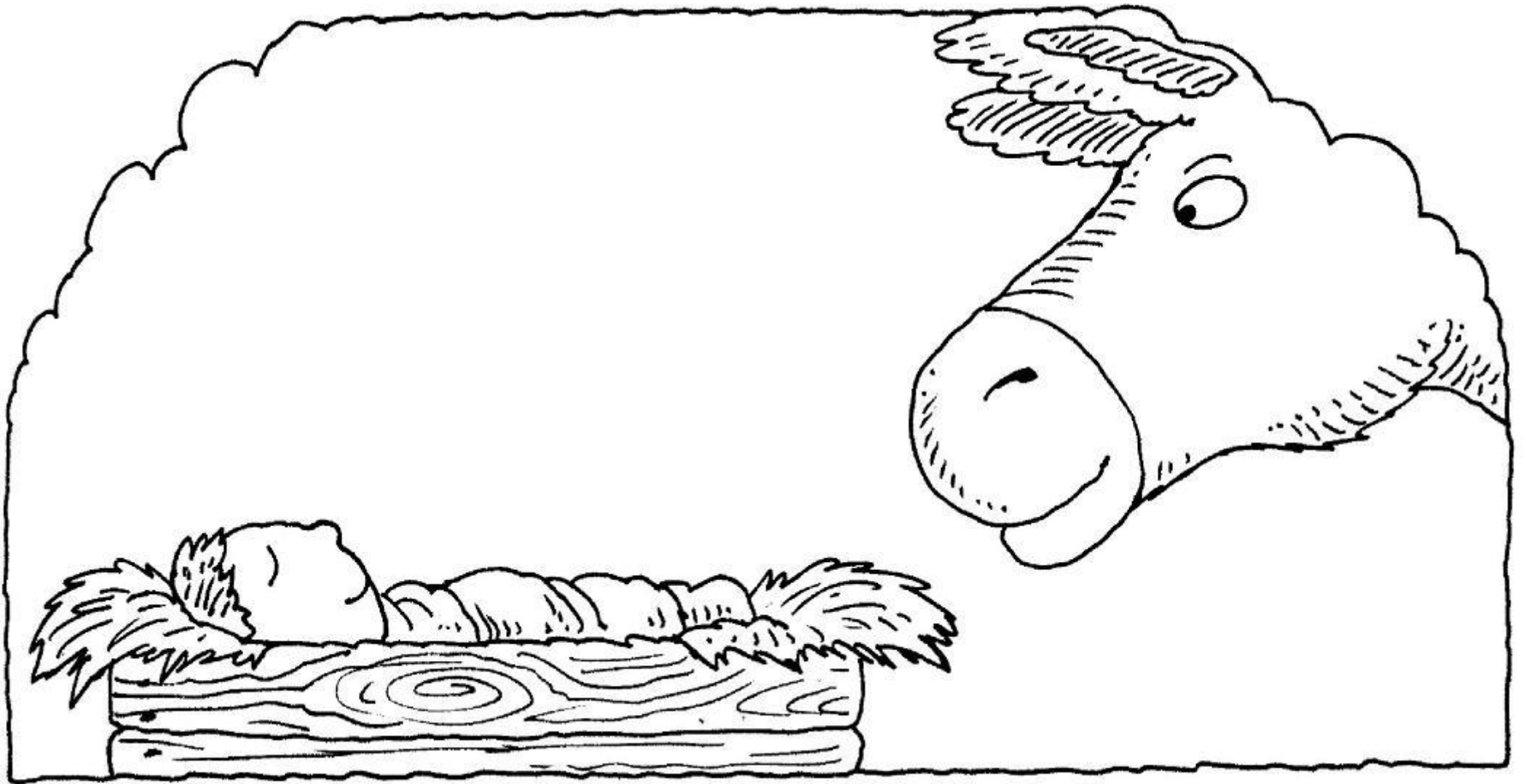
They could see the town on top of the hill
