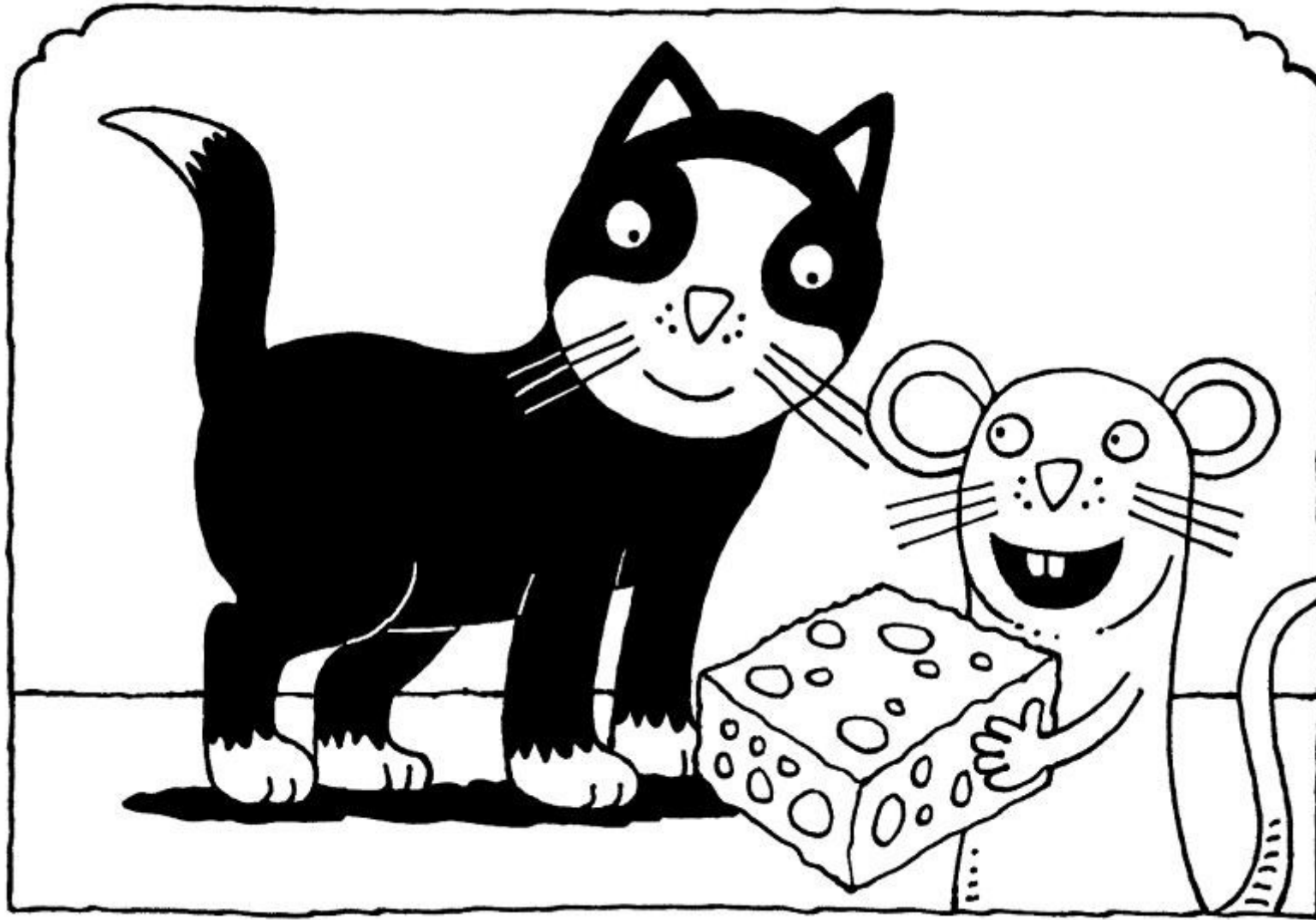

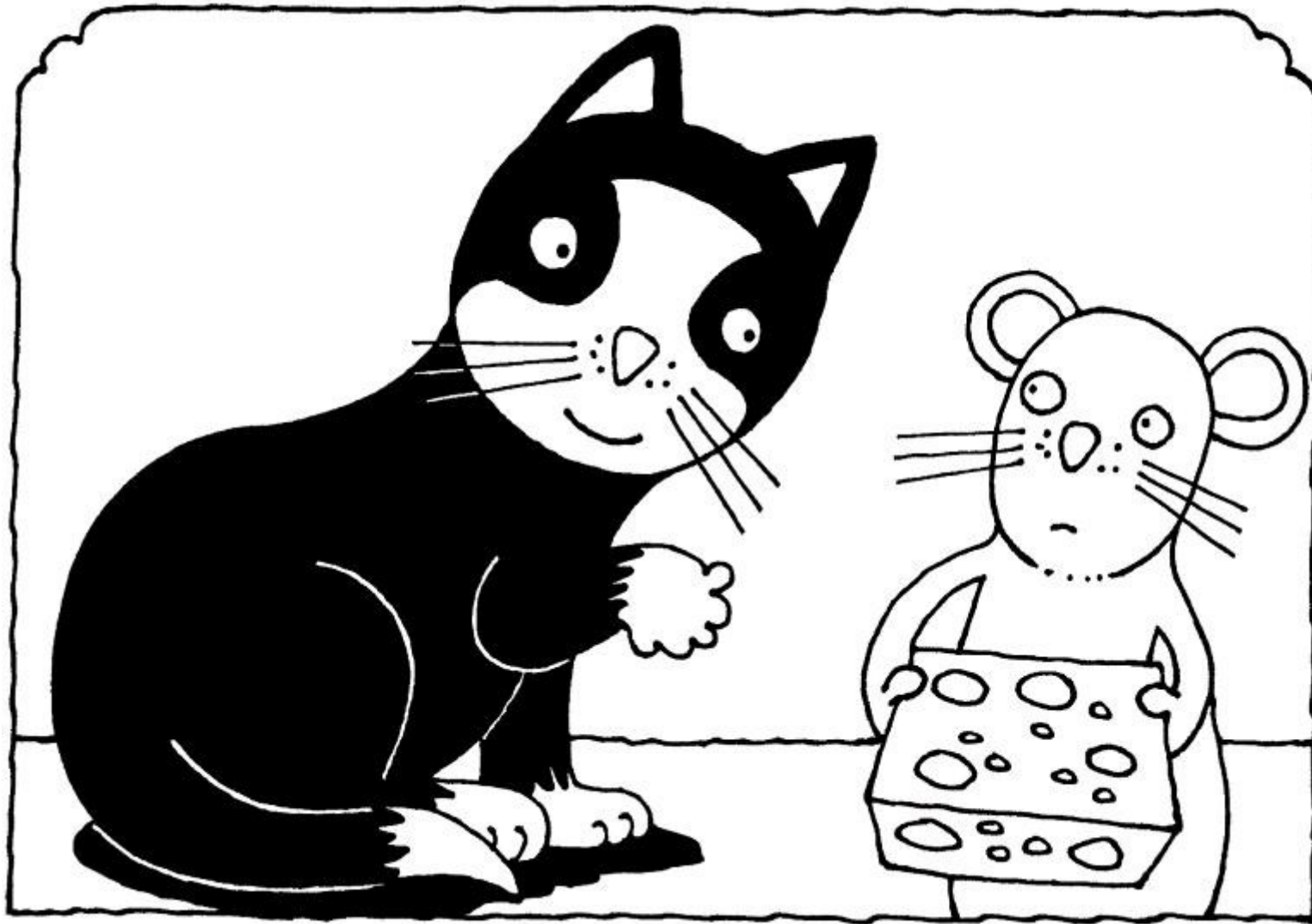


Be thankful to Him.

I will thank her for buying it for me.”



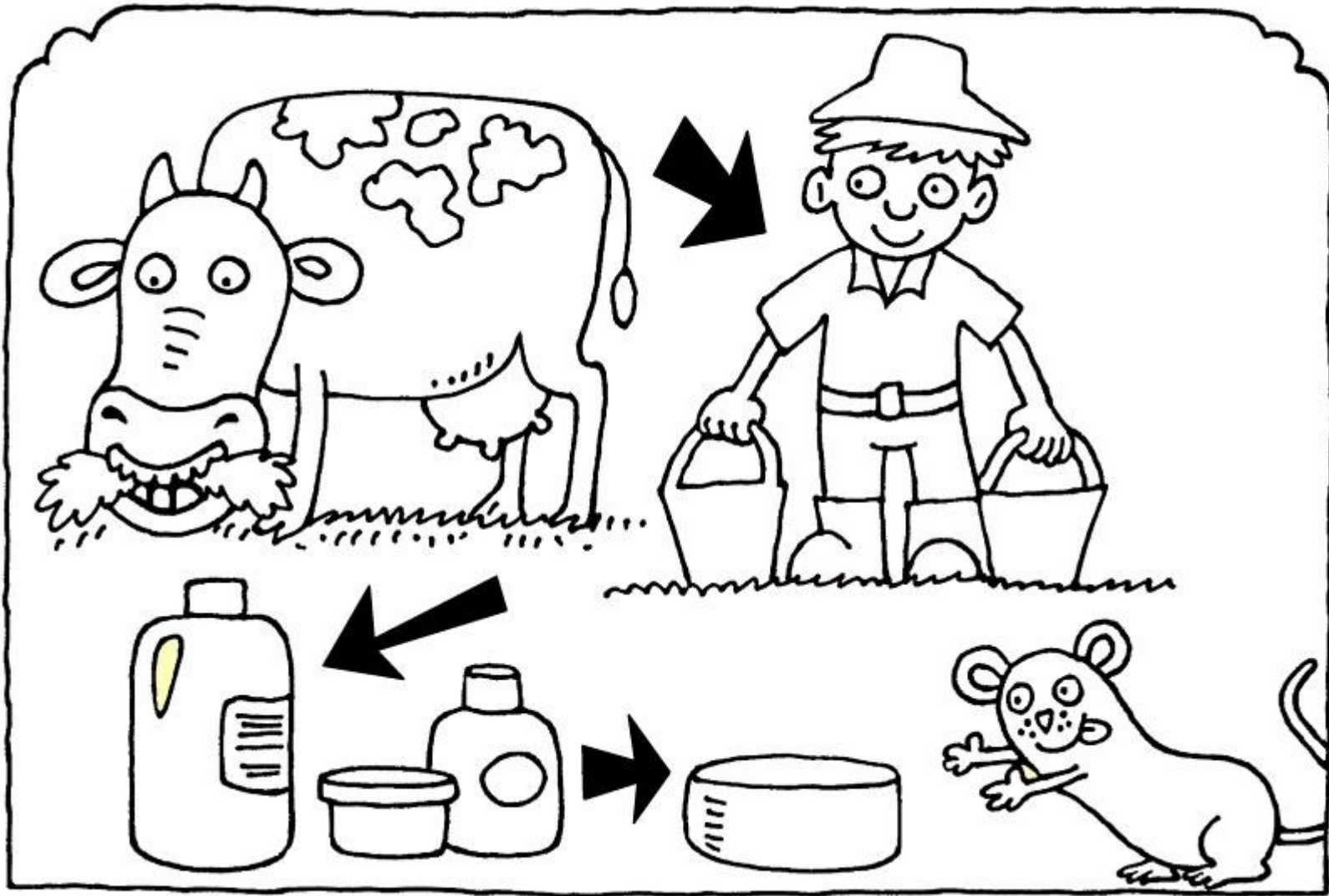
“Remember to thank God, too,” Luca said.

“God gives us the food we eat.”

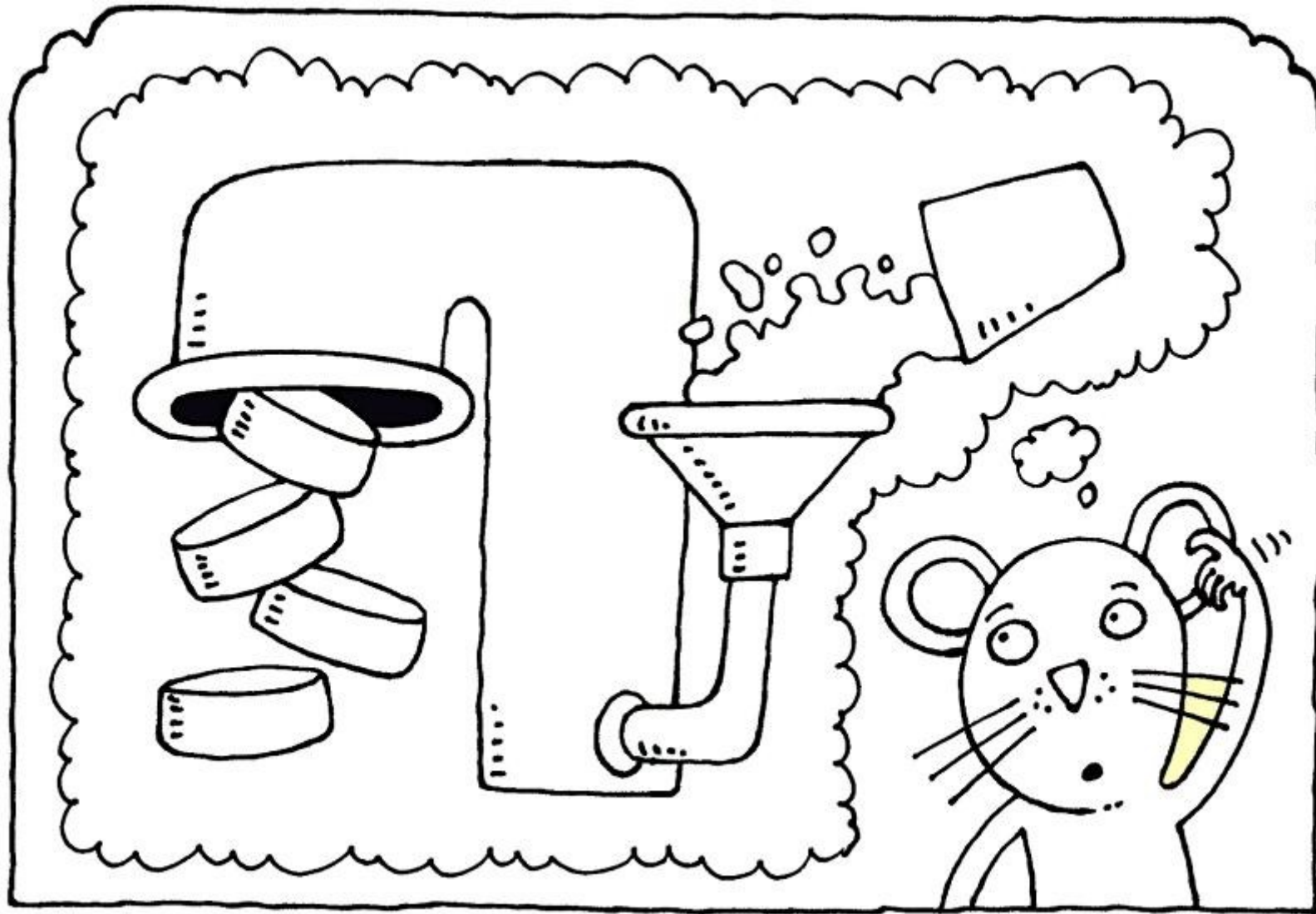
“But the cheese came from the shop,”
said Samuel. “God didn’t make it!”



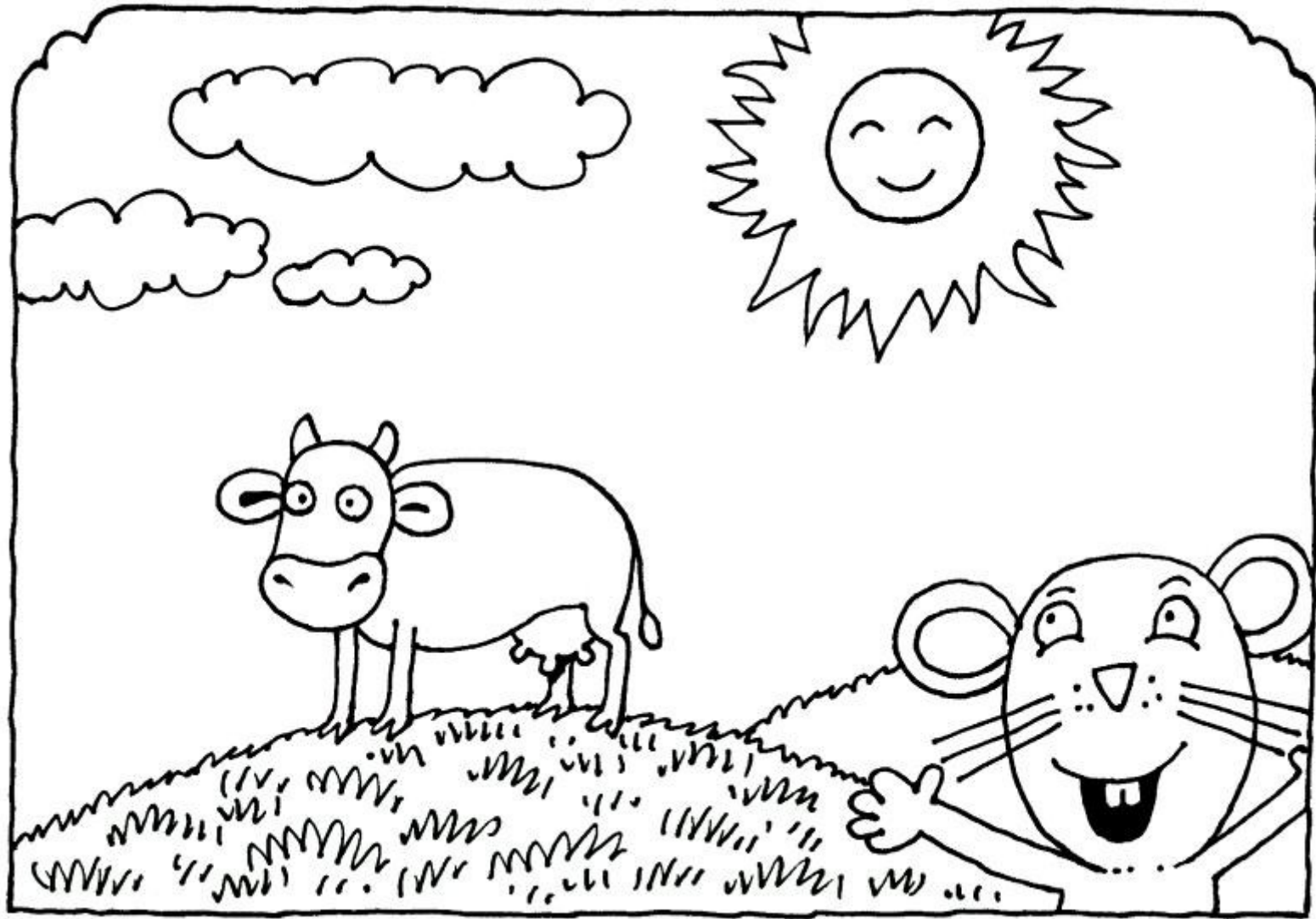
“The Bible tells us that God made animals. God designed cows to turn grass into milk. Cheese is made from the cream in the milk,” Luca explained to Samuel.



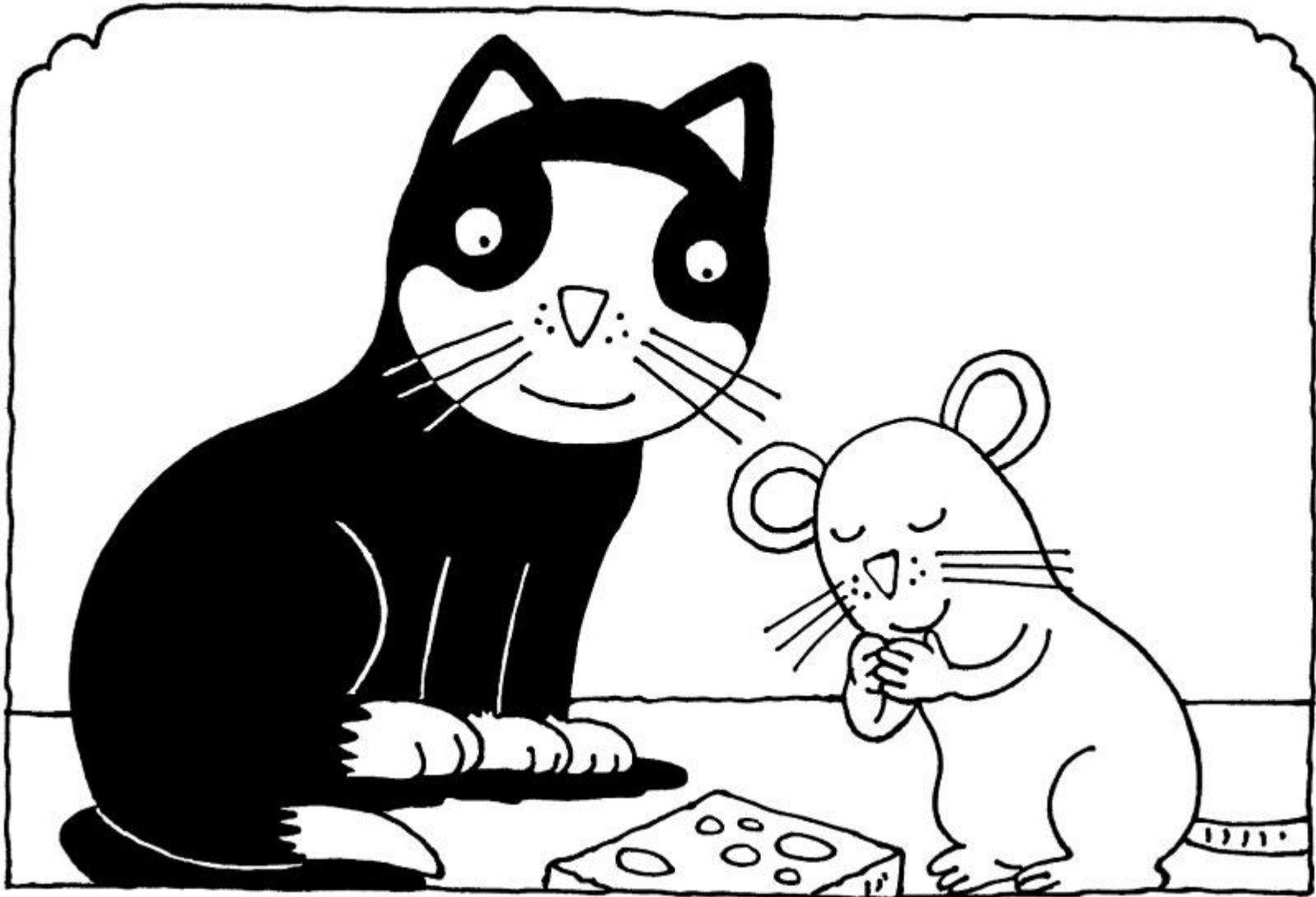
“The farmer milks the cows and sends the cream to the cheese factory!” Samuel smiled, “Now I understand that without God I wouldn’t have cheese!”
