Lesson

*Flash Card or book about Sheep that was lost.

(or your own resource.)

*There are many books available about the “Good Shepherd” or the “Lost Sheep.” The point of difference in this story is that it is about Jesus and Precious Lamb - YOU are Jesus’ Precious Lamb.

He loves us and wants us to listen to him. Being near Jesus keeps us happy and safe.

Act out story of a lost lamb with toy sheep or make card ones. Hide one and have the children look for it.

See how happy we are to find the lost one. We only need to call out to Jesus and he always hears.

Talk about listening to other people when they tell us to do silly things.

Lamb Puppet

Child's Name " Jesus Loves You."

Activity

Puppet face on paper bag or front & back of Lamb face stapled to fit hand inside.

Use to sing "Jesus has a Precious Lamb" Noah's Ark 6

Prayer

Thank God that Jesus loves us so much and that he is always near. Help us to remember to love Jesus and follow him.
