Story: Tell The Truth – Rose and Daisy.

Lesson Aim: Story about truth, honesty, stealing, jealousy, friendship, forgiveness.

Verse

Always tell the truth.
Ephesians 4:25

Lesson

Look at book: “Tell The Truth. Rose and Daisy.”

Props to act out story:

Two dolls pictures or puppets.

Rose needs a pocket.

Some necklaces.

A jewellery box, with lid that can fall off.

Act out story.

What did Rose do?

- She was jealous
- She was sneaky
- She touched someone's things
- Broke it accidentally

- She took something that wasn't hers – that is called stealing.
- Wasn't honest
- Told a lie
- Prayed and told God she was sorry
- Said sorry to Daisy.
- Daisy was a good friend – she forgave Rose.
- It is nice when we can really be happy for someone else when they get something nice. It will be our turn some other time.

Puppet

Use two butterflies on sticks. Rhyme:
Butterfly Friends by Wendy Webster from
Butterfly Blue CD – see Lambsongs.

Activity

Shape of jewellery box (website) and base. Cut card shape and tape half way up base, to make “pocket,” inside, so necklace doesn't fall out. Cut out card necklace with verse. Thread hat elastic etc. A small Bible can fit in pocket too.

Prayer

Give booklet of story to take home.

Pray with children for someone sick.

Using puppet or mirror say “Child’s Name “Jesus Loves You.”

Teacher needs:

Noah’s Ark CD – From www.lambsong.co.nz CD player

Butterfly friends.

Props to act out story:

Two dolls – Rose and Daisy - pictures or puppets. Rose needs a pocket.

Some necklaces.

A jewellery box, with lid that can fall off.

A Bible.

Puppet to tell **each child** by name “...God Loves you etc.”

Or mirror “Can you see who does Jesus loves? “
