Book: Washing Feet – by Jill Kemp

- Look through the book. Talk about the pictures.
 - Read the story
 - Peter thought that Jesus was too important to wash HIS dirty smelly feet!
 - But Jesus said that it was showing love and kindness to his friends.
 - Who is the most important person here? - Teacher etc.
 - Jesus showed his friends that He was not too important to do small jobs like washing dirty feet to show love and help others.

- Washing their feet after they had walked a long way and their feet were dusty and dirty and sore from the stony roads, **made them feel so comfortable and cared for.**

- **Let's see how nice it feels.**

- Wash feet, look into child's eyes.
- Tell " Aliya etc, Jesus loves you."
- Dry gently.
- Get children to take turns gently massaging lotion on each other's feet.
- It feels so nice.

- Teacher will need:

- Low chairs for young child to reach
- Bowl of warm water.
- Soap or foot bath lotion
- Towel
- Hand lotion
- Floor protection
