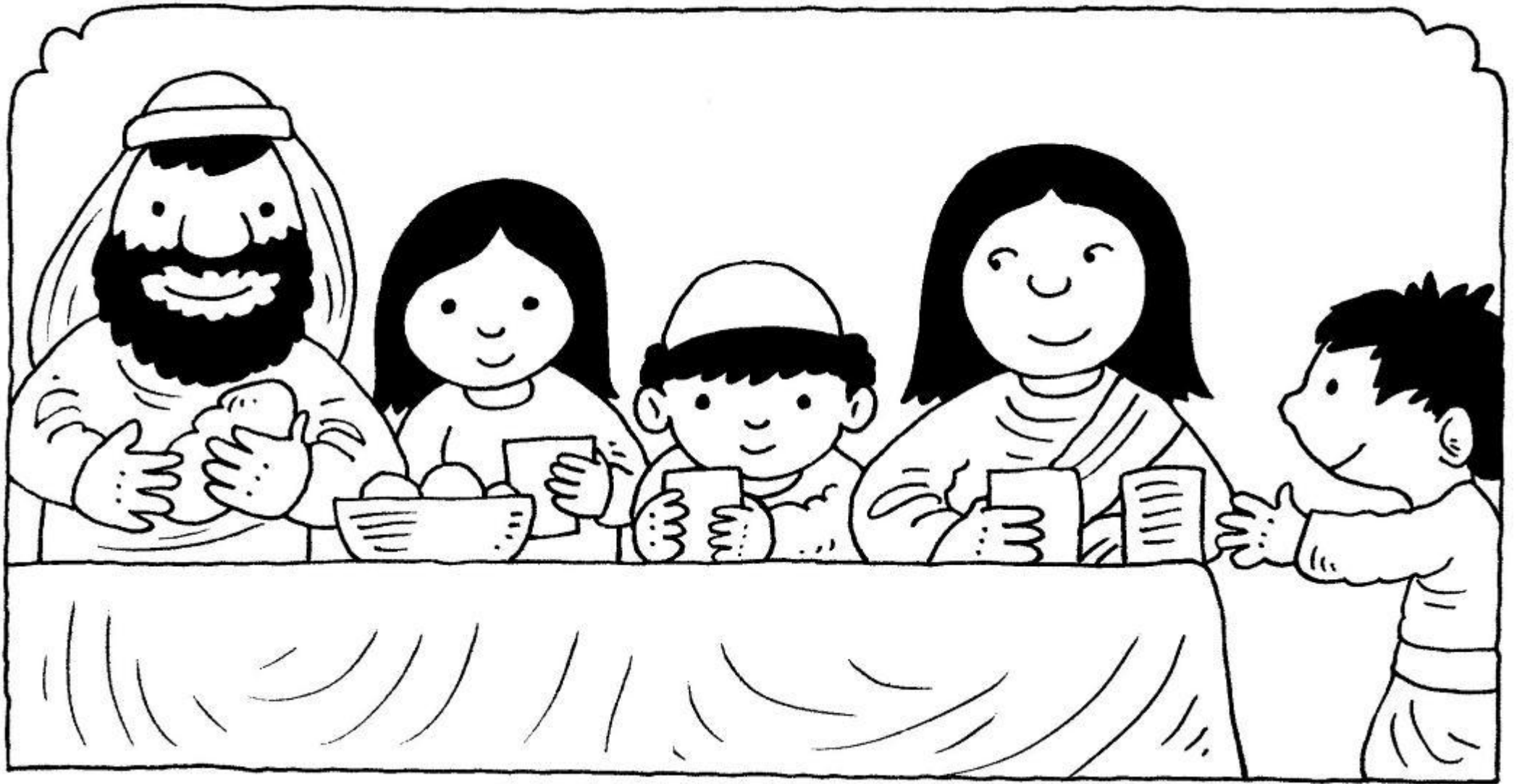

He was respectful to his parents and kind to others.



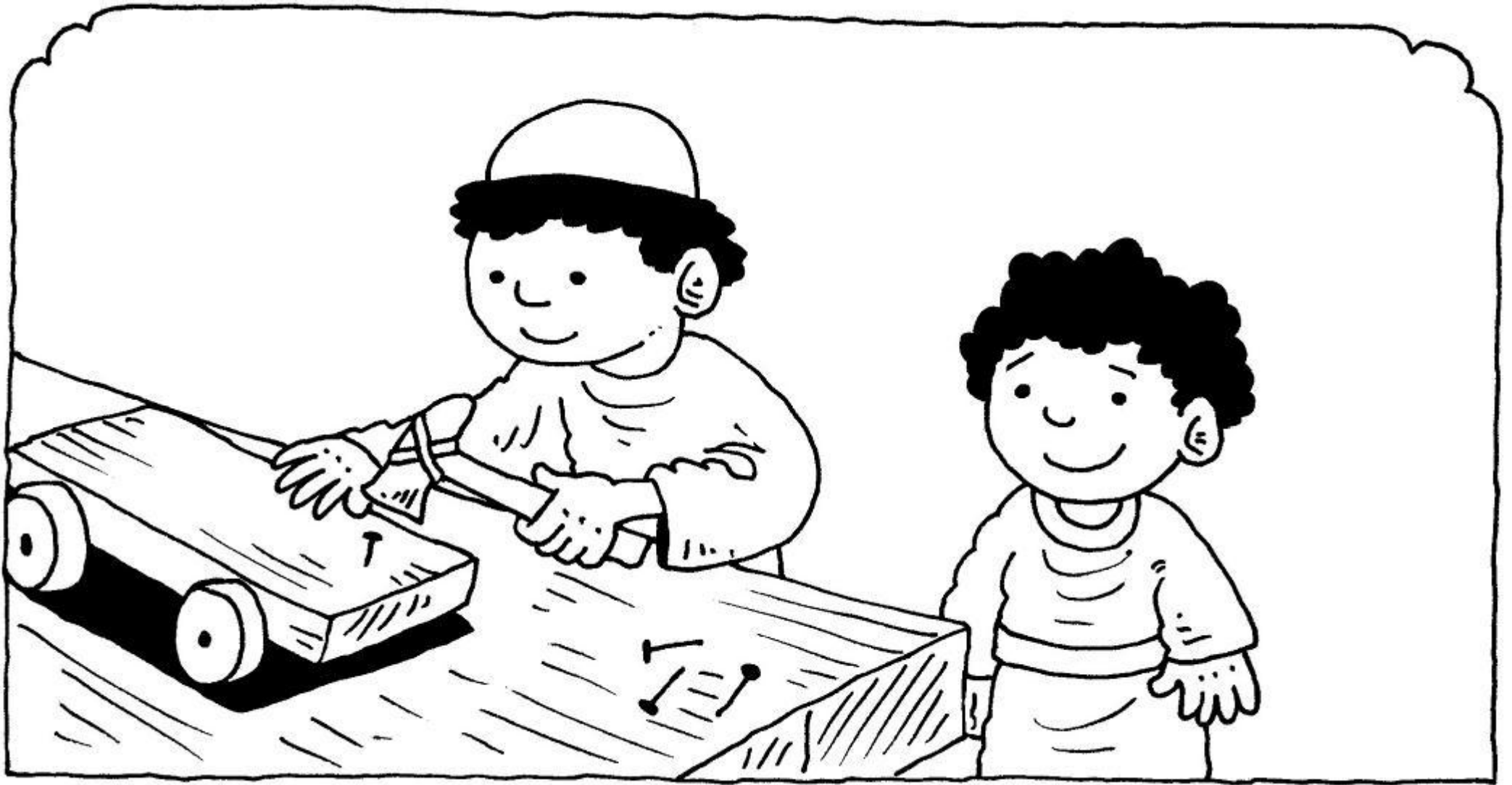
Jesus was a child like me.

child, he loved riding on their donkey.



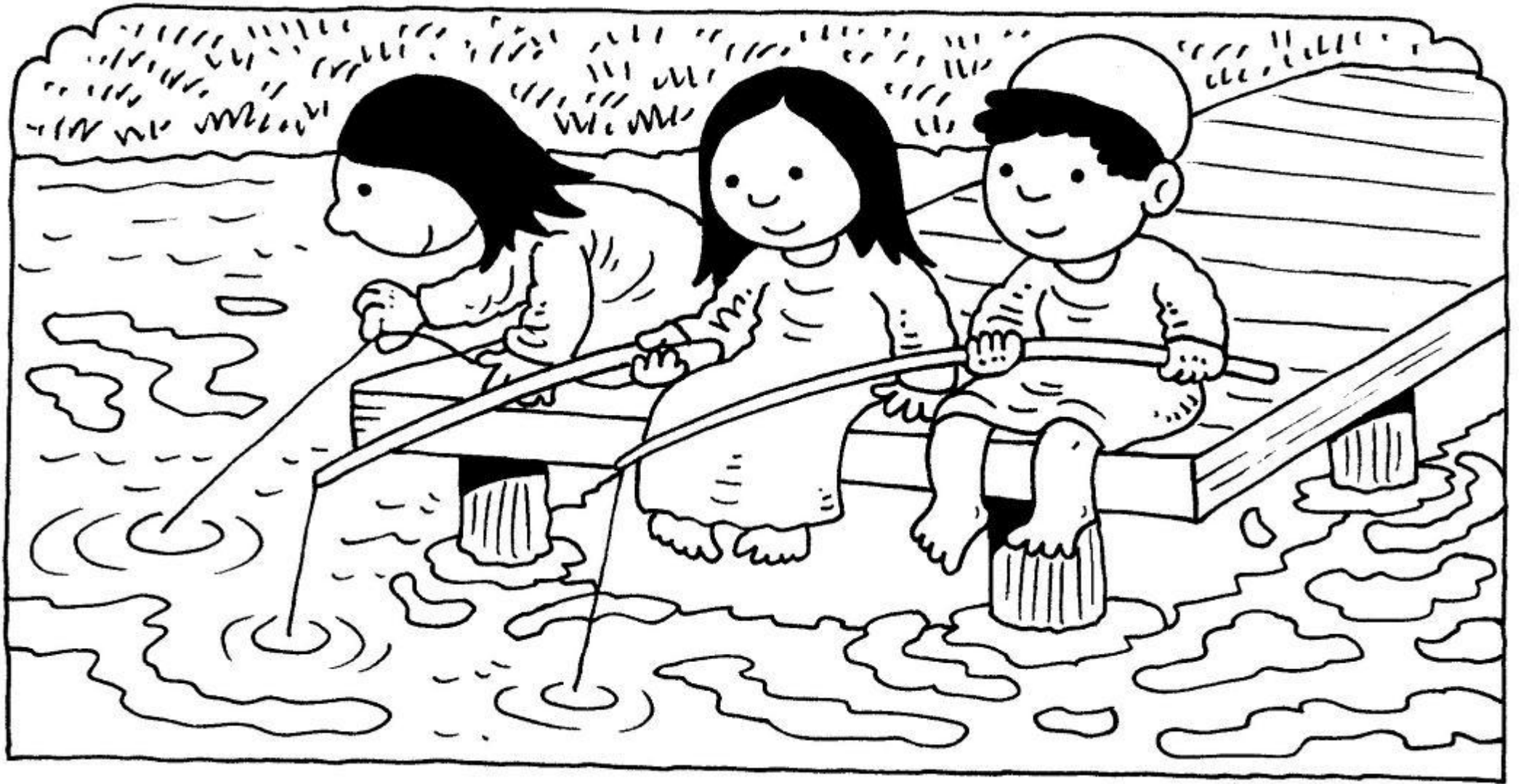
They lived in the village of Nazareth and would often have family and friends come to visit. Sharing happy times with them was important.



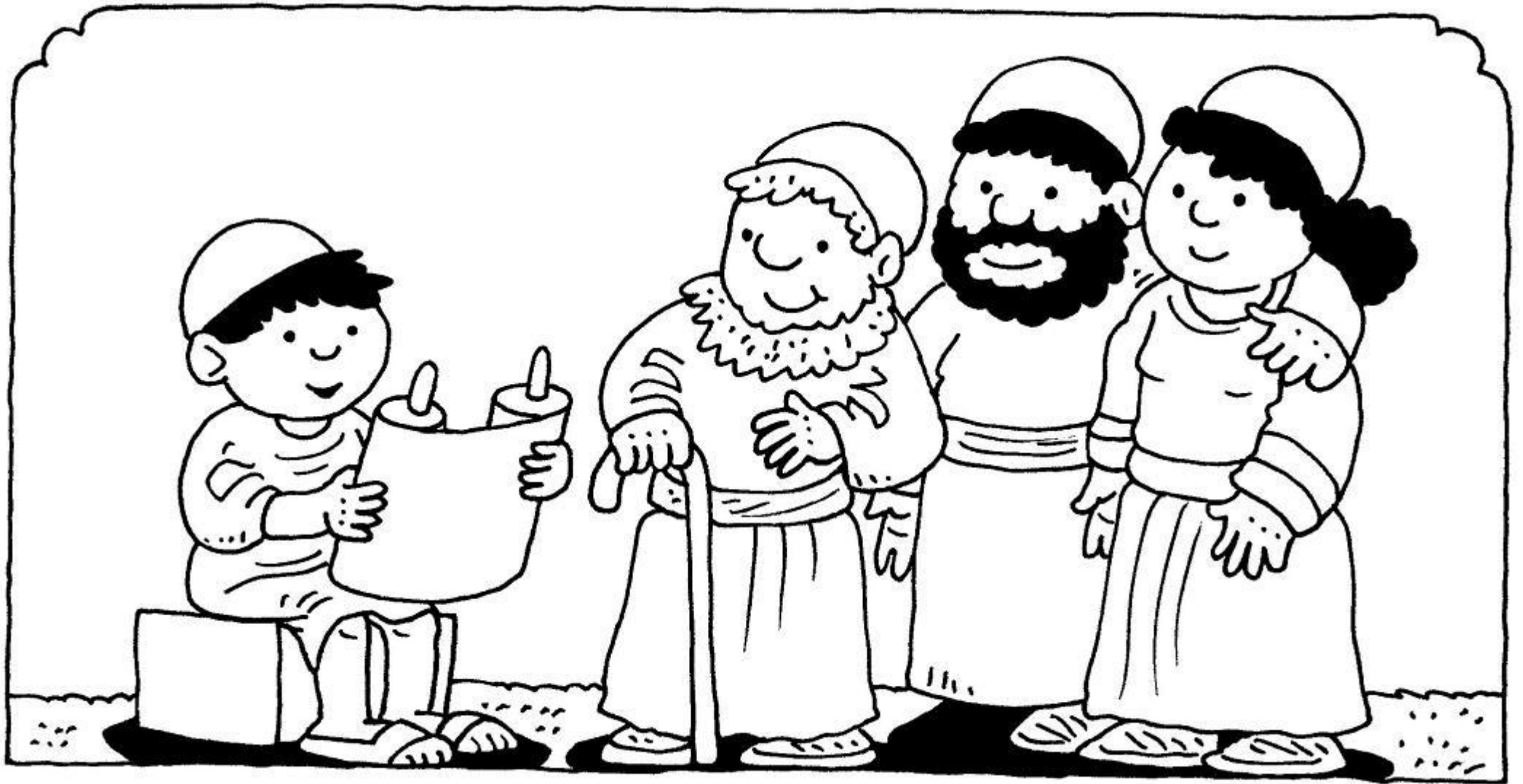
Jesus was the oldest child

and he loved them all.



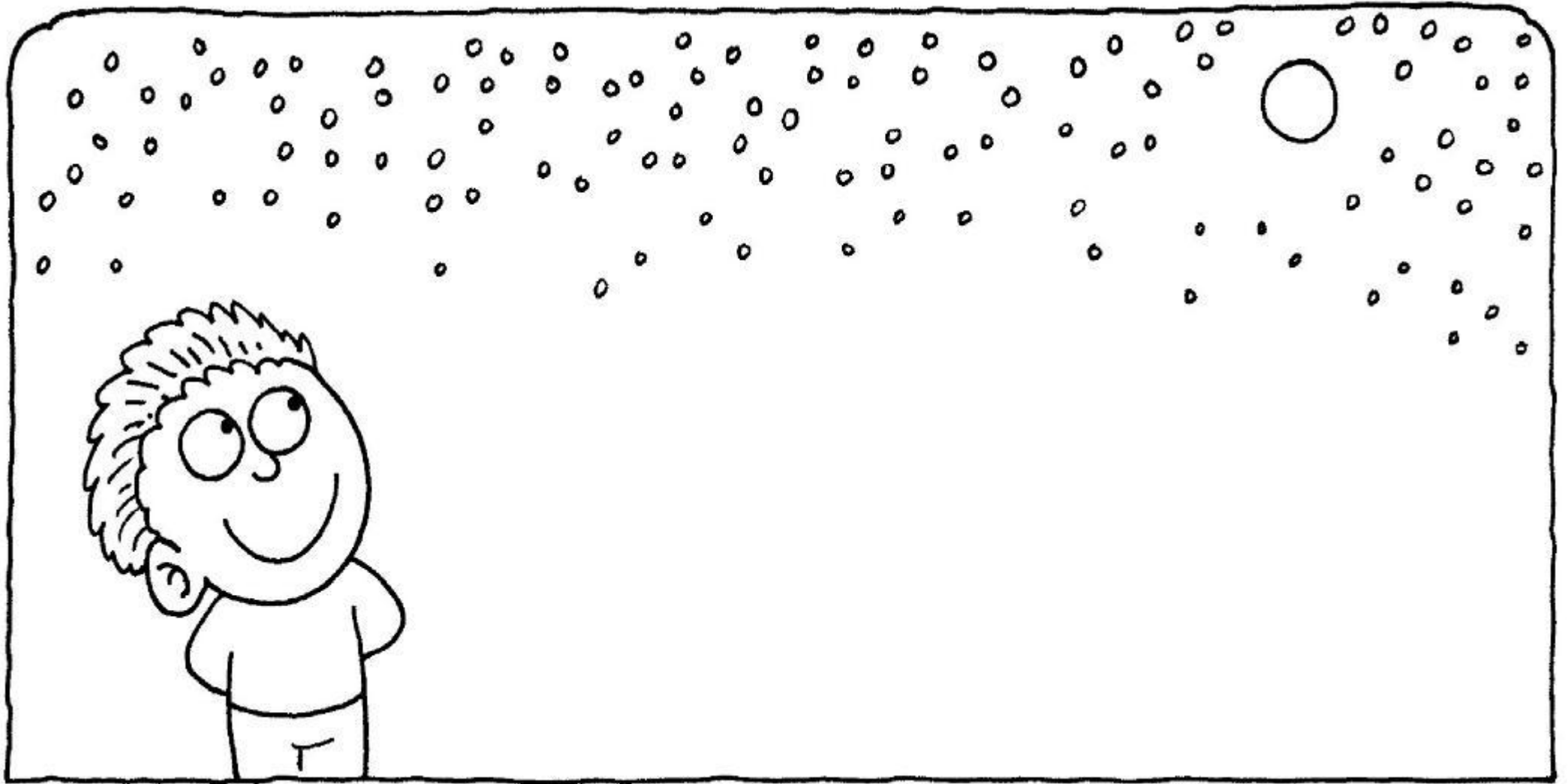
Joseph was a carpenter and
