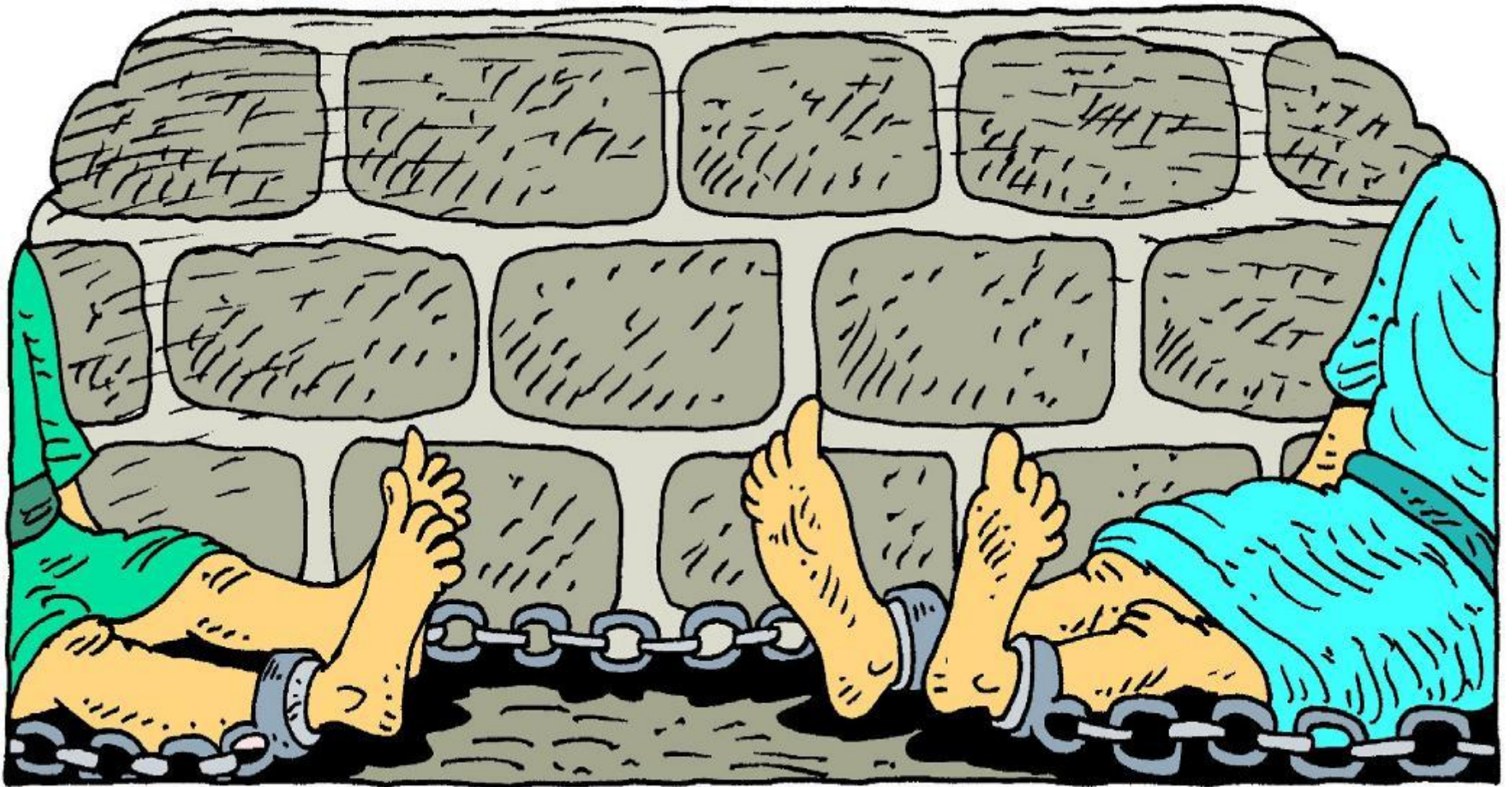


Paul And Silas Sing In Jail

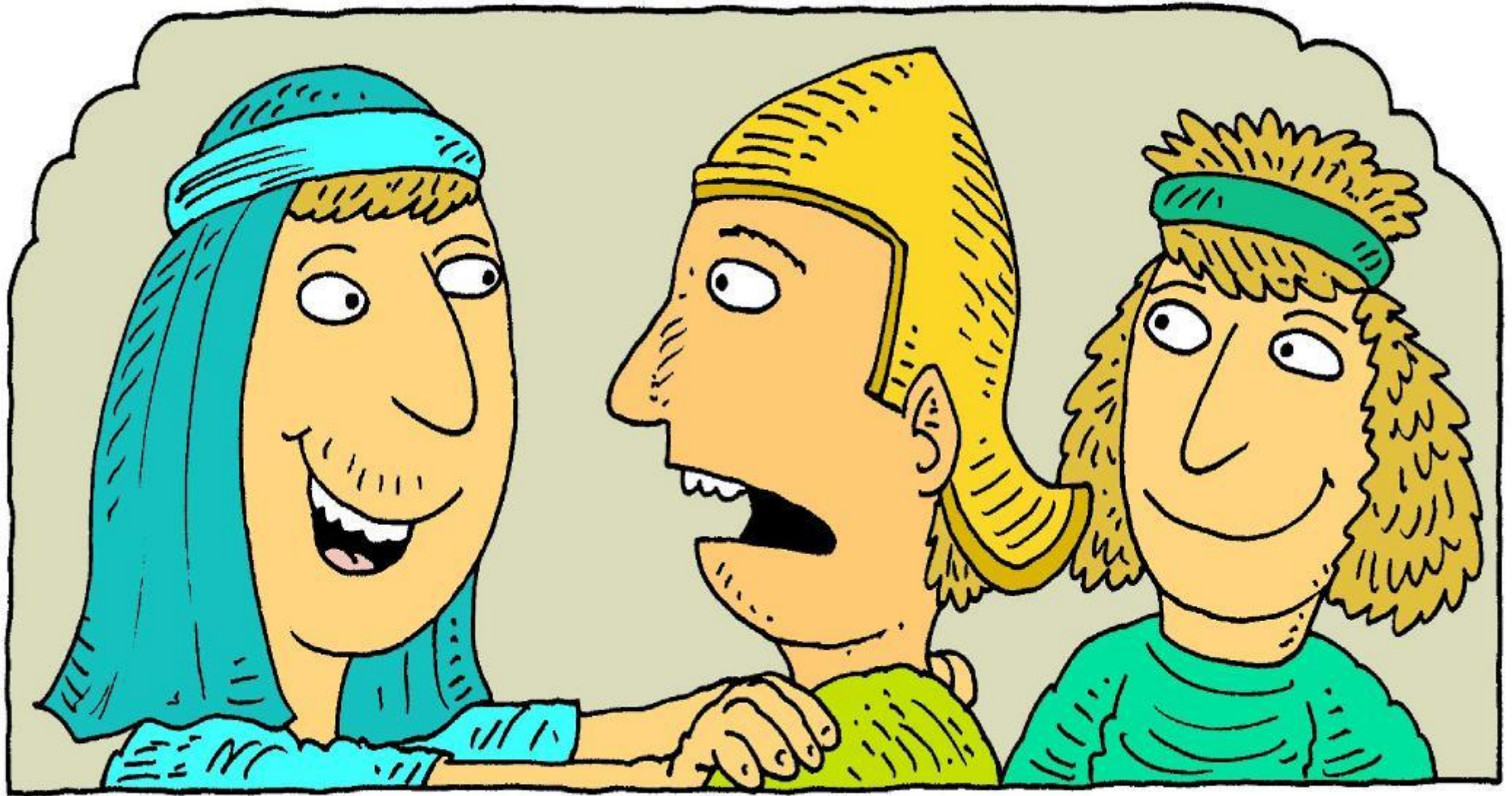
They cheered each other up with words from the Bible

If the prisoners escaped they would be in trouble.

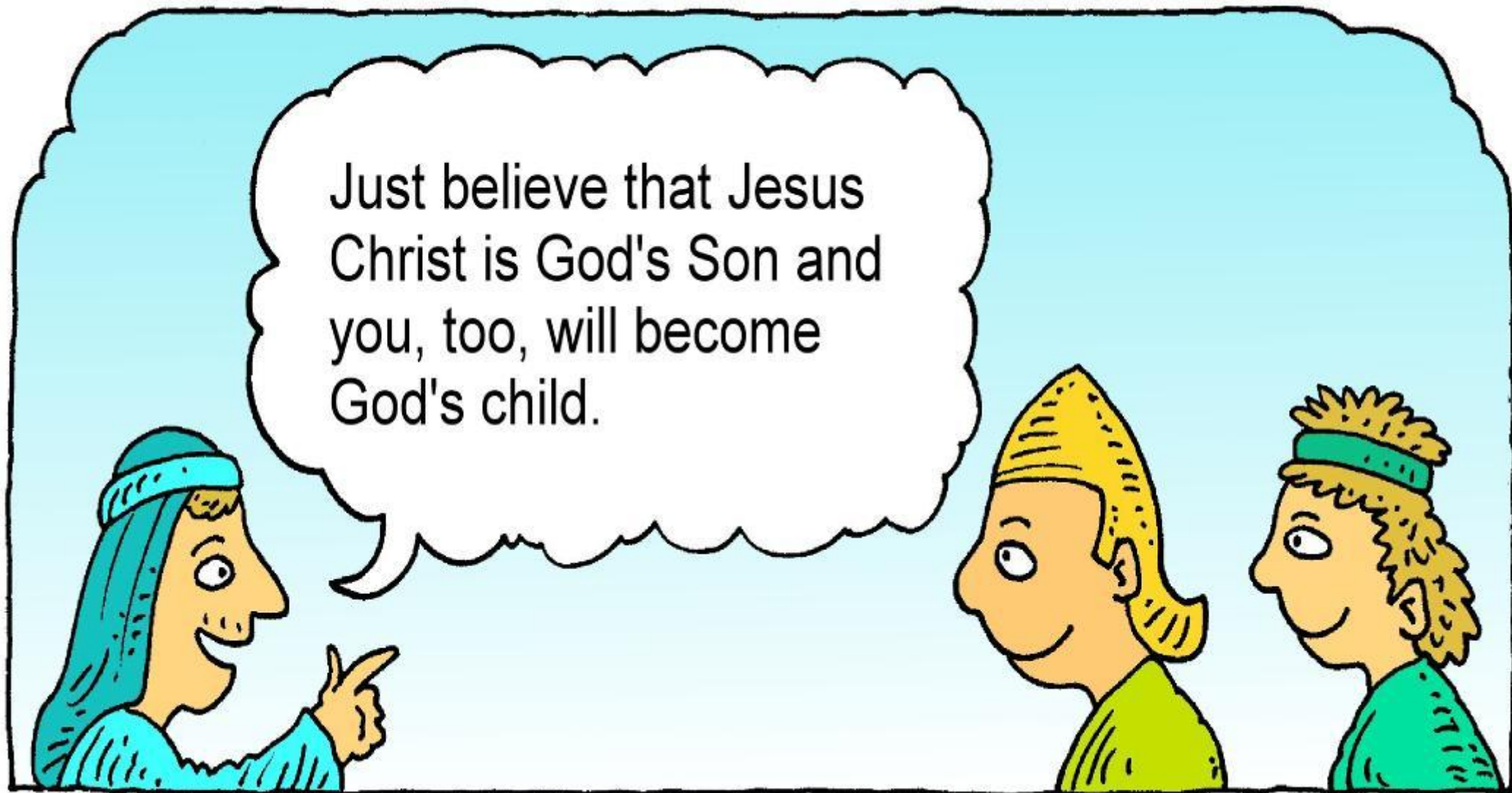


But, Paul and Silas did not run away.
