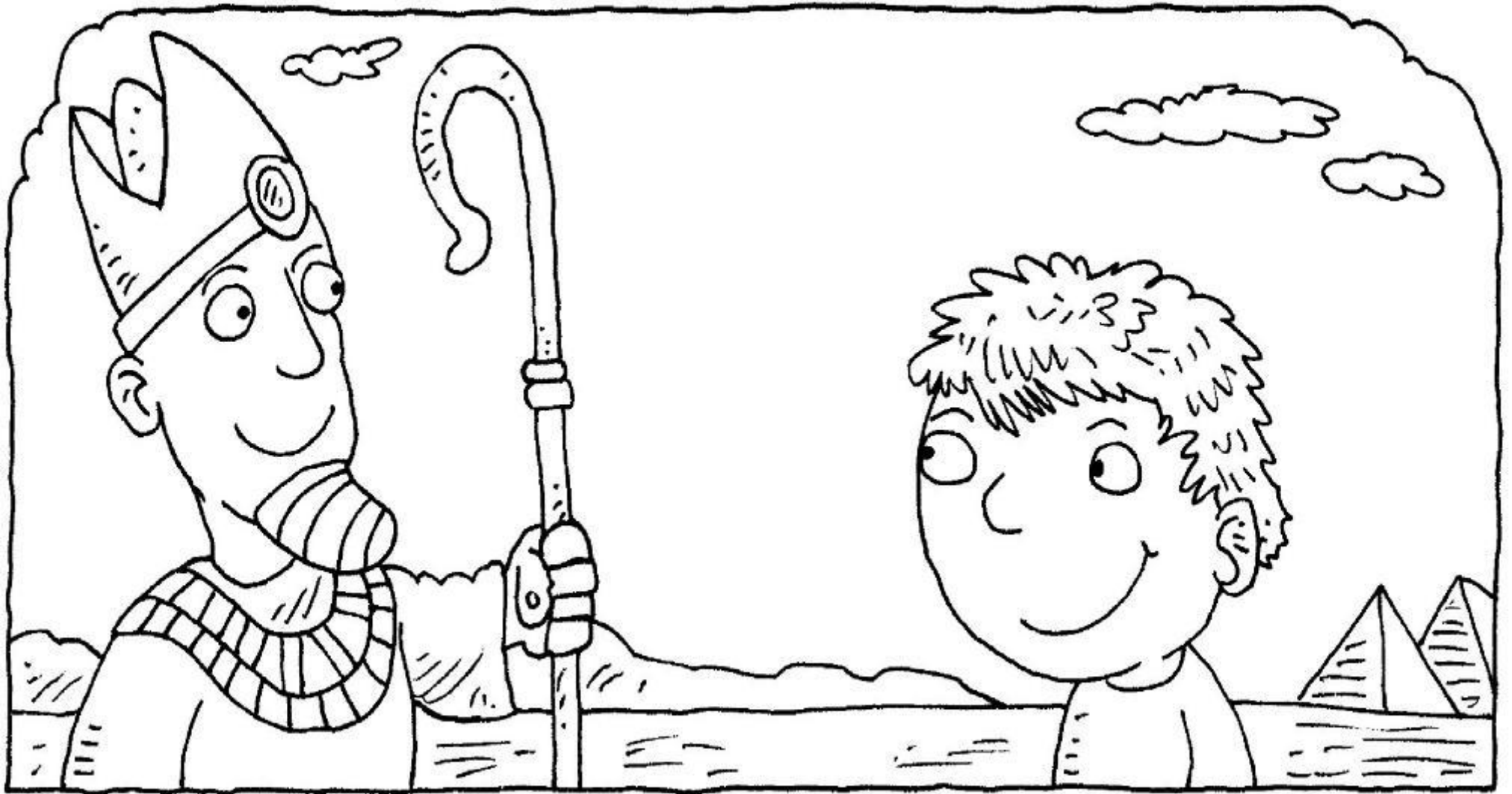

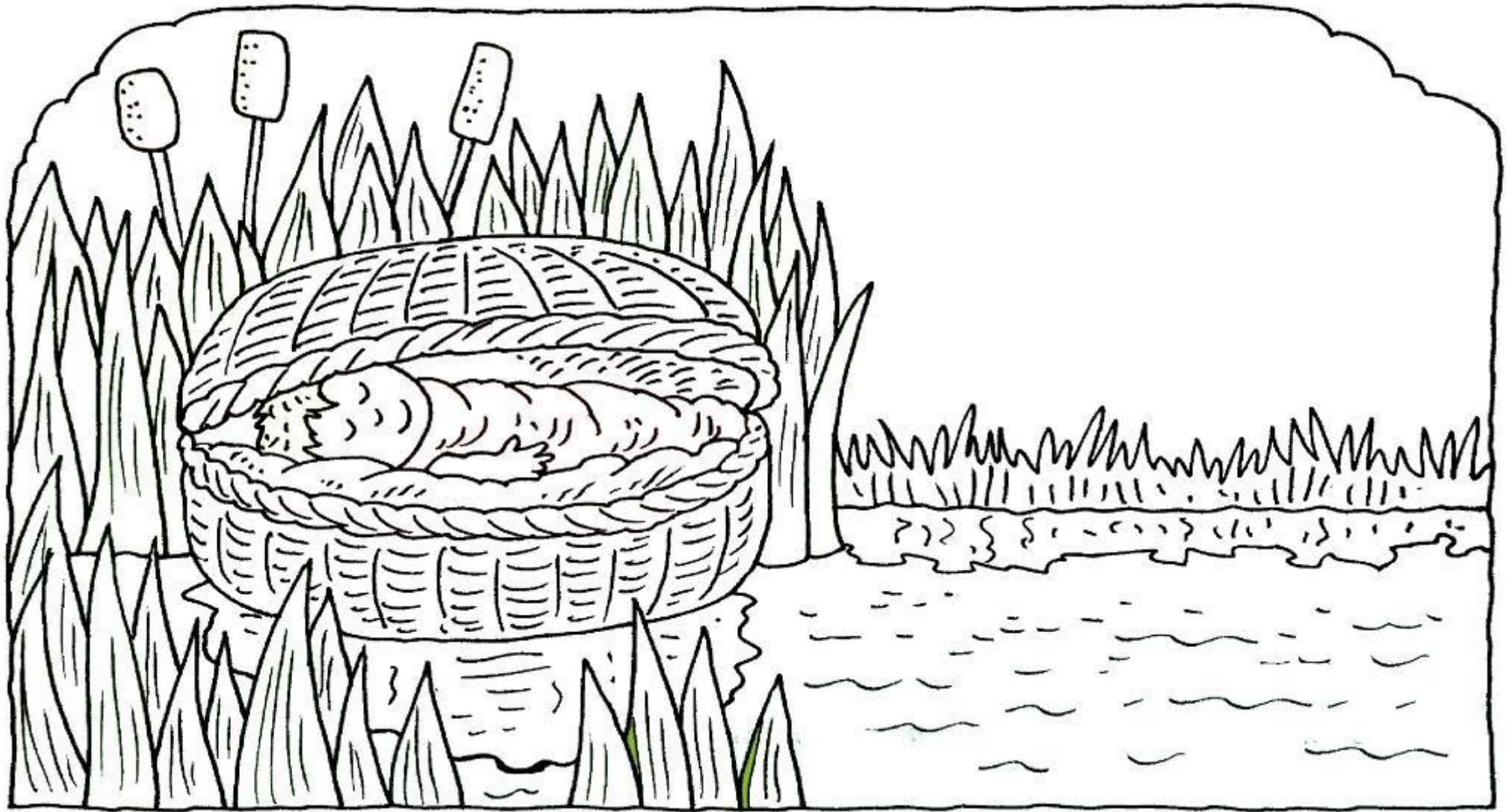
The Bible tells me

and everything in it.



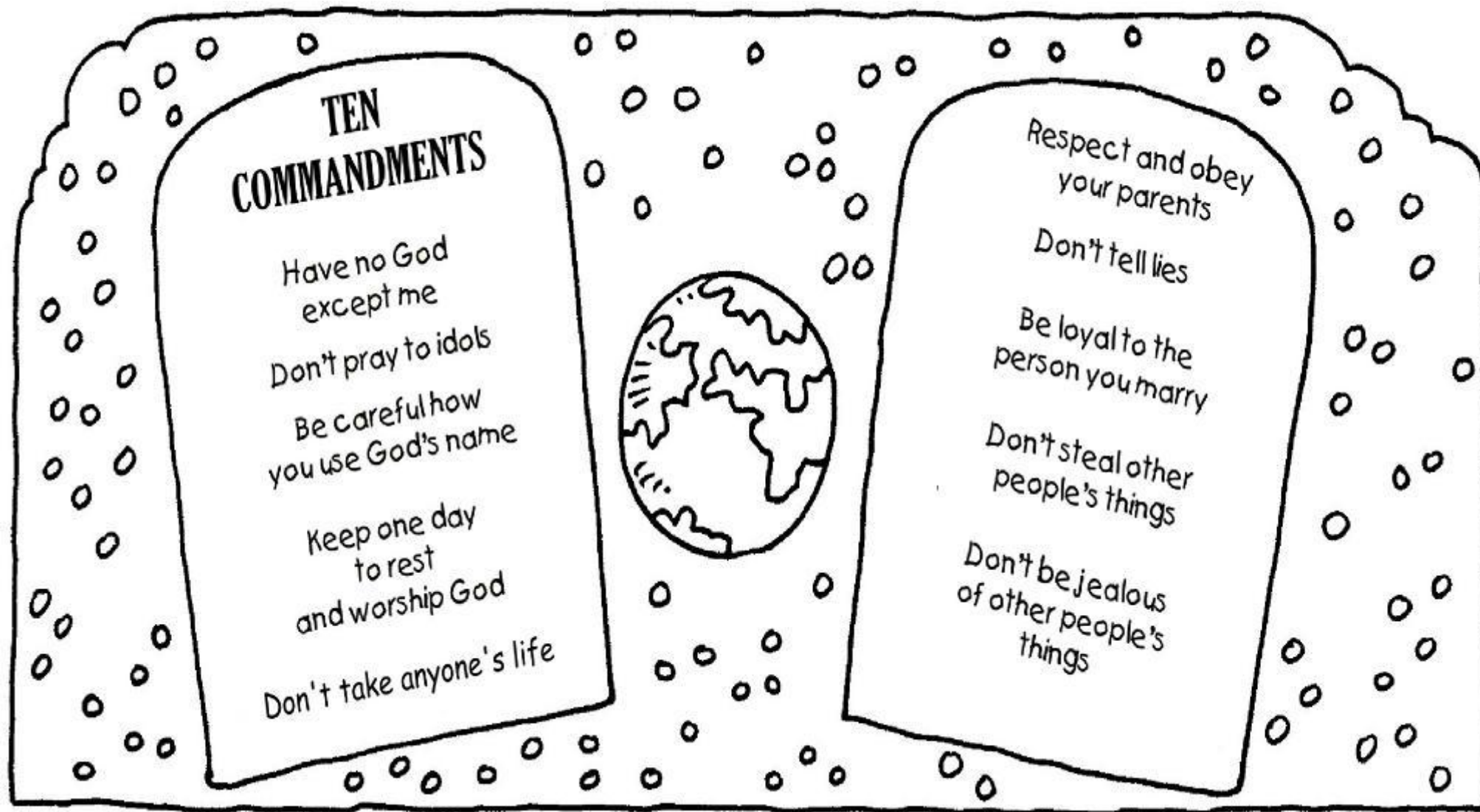
It says that God told Noah to build a big boat

your parents

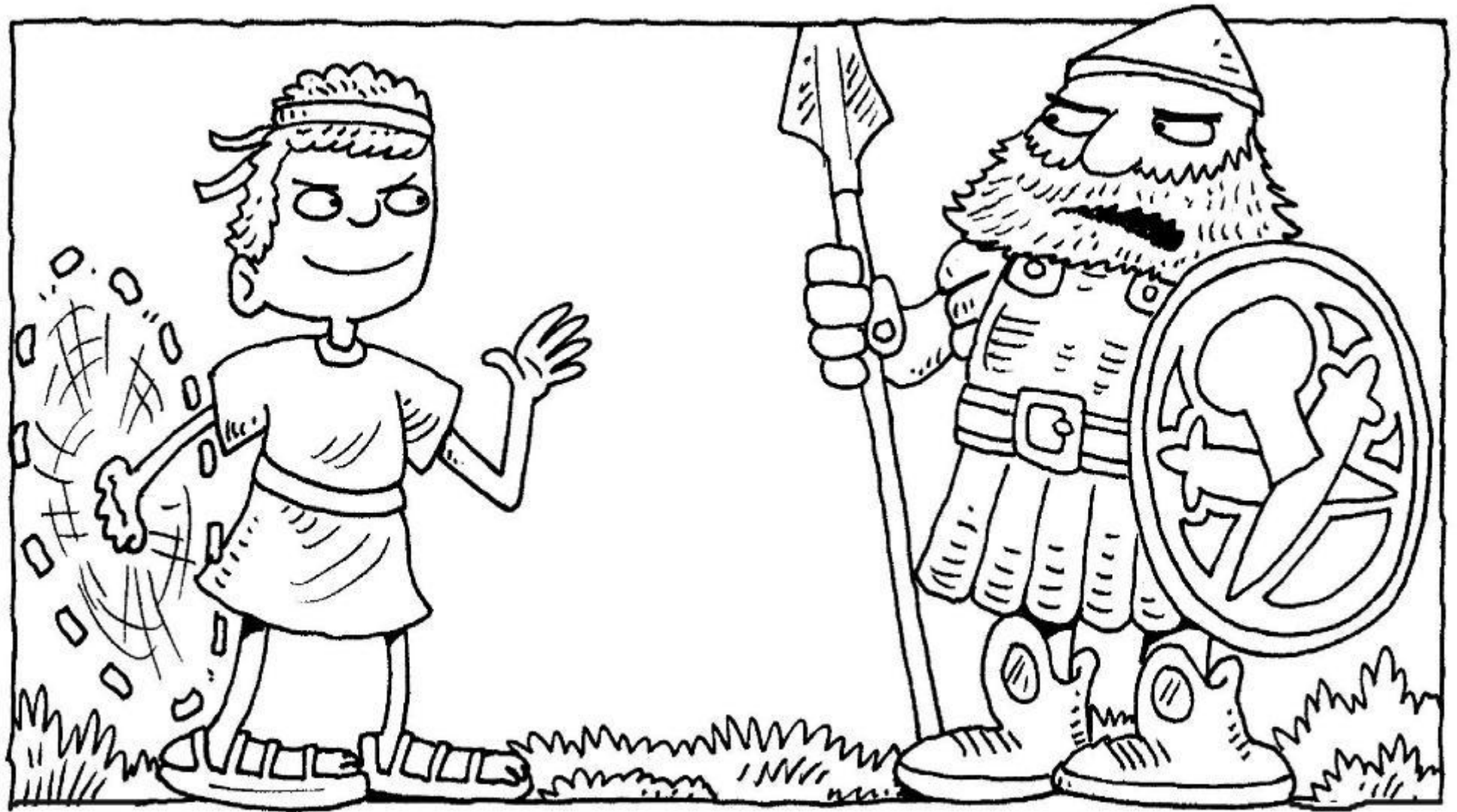
Don't tell lies

person you marry

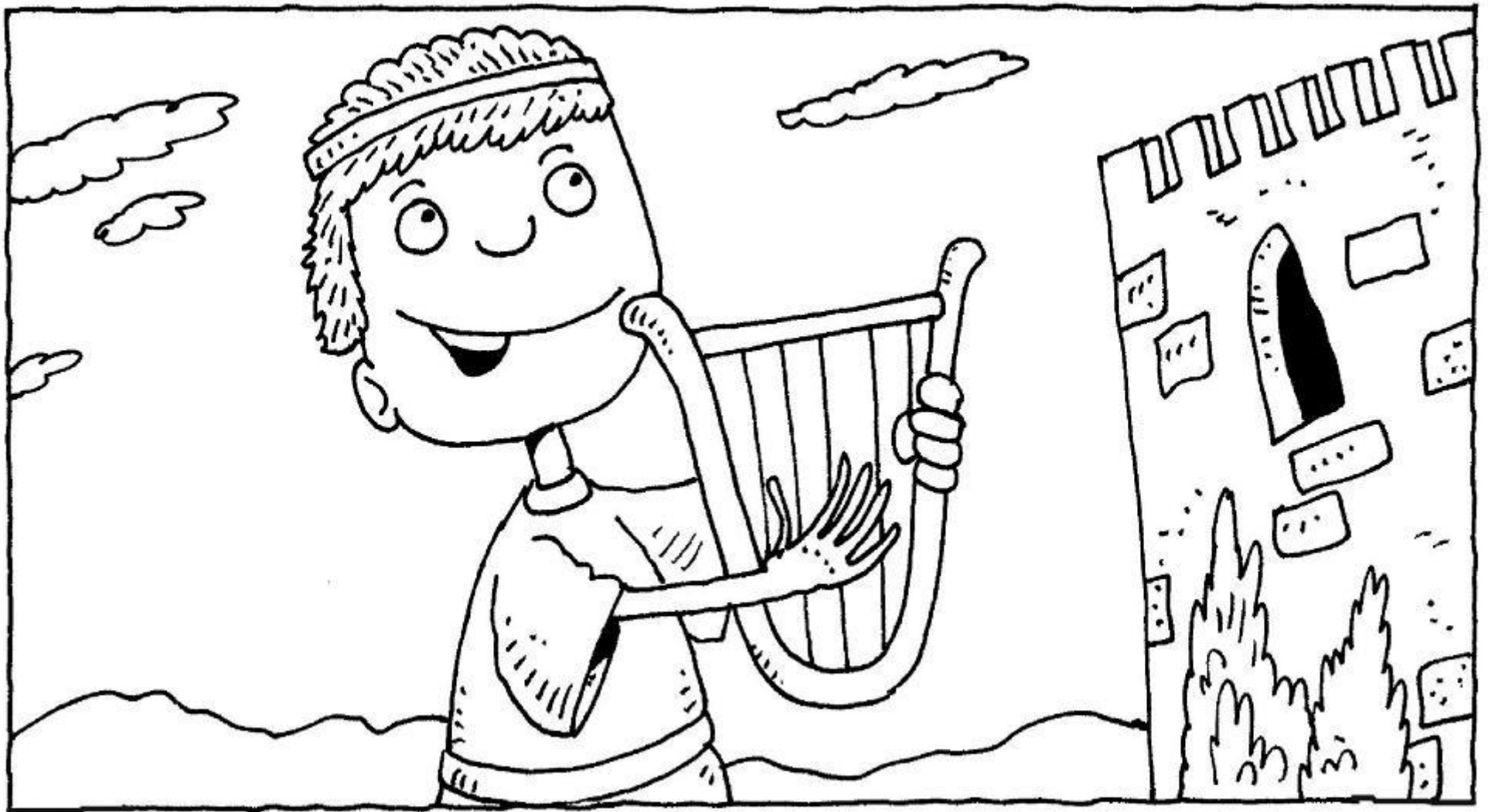
Don't steal other

things

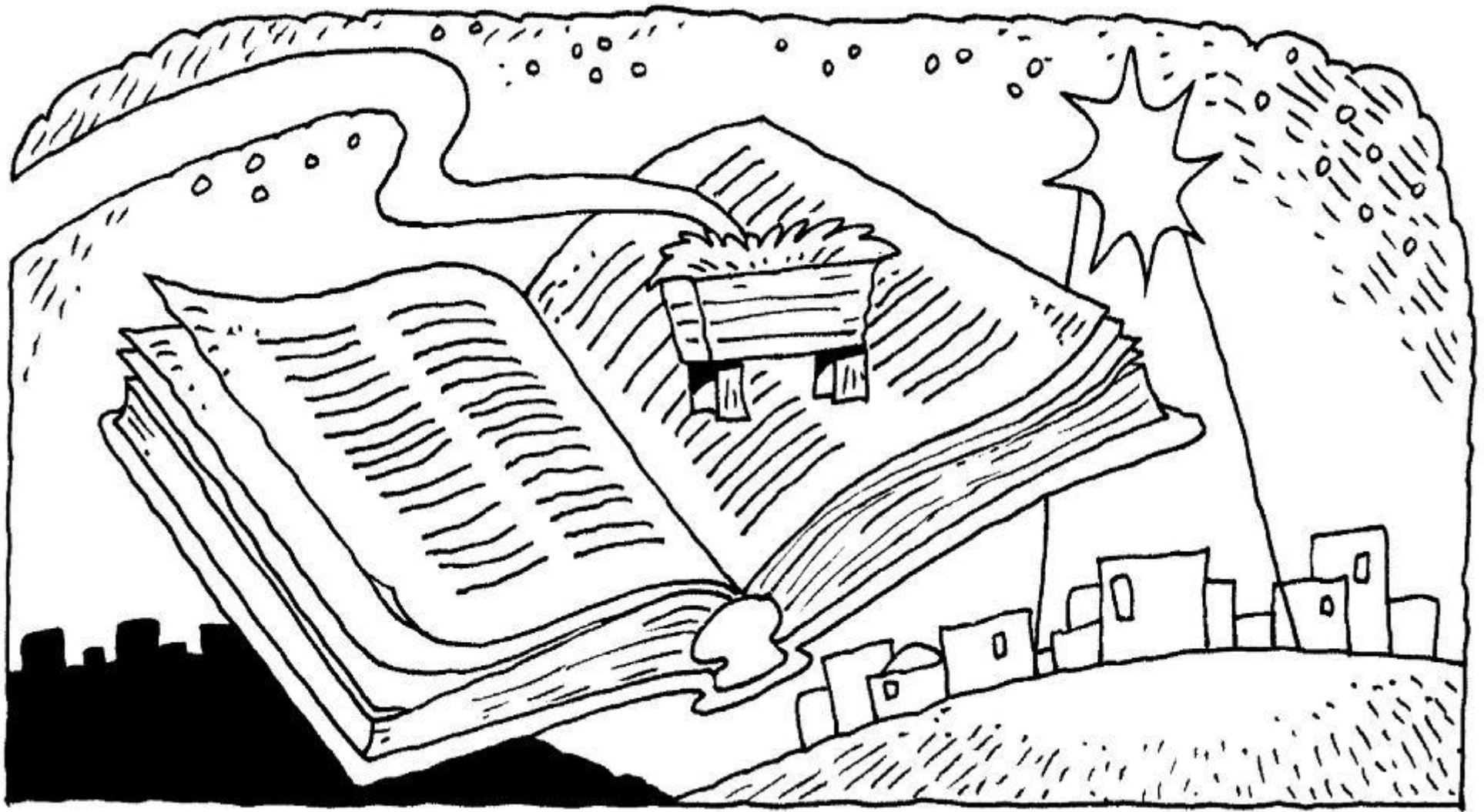
When he was a grown up into a man, God gave Moses the Ten Commandments, on two big stones. They tell us to do what is good and right.
