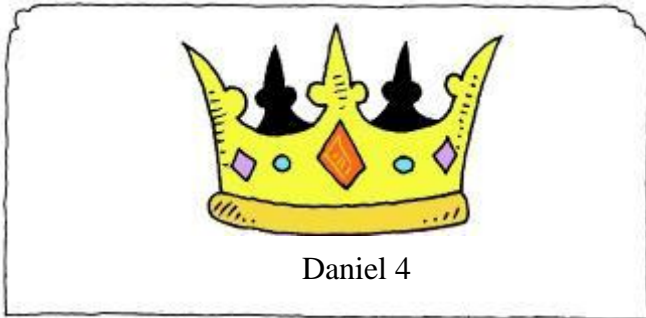


NEBUCHADNEZZER the very proud King
